

#### M I S S I O N S T A T E M E N T

"We, the community of St. Gregory Barbarigo, are called forth in Baptism to follow the mission of Jesus to teach, to love, and to serve."



This past weekend we had 125 people at the 5 PM Mass and 150 people at the 10:30 AM Mass. I am elated that people want to return to Mass, but also worried that we are exceeding our safe limit for numbers. The question arises: Do we need to add another Mass so that more can come? If we add a Mass, it would be temporary, only until we have COVID-19 restrictions relaxed. When we go back to the old normal, then the extra Mass would drop. Consider that another Mass would also entail another set of people to clean up afterwards, usher, be Extraordinary Ministers, etc. Recently we have had some problems getting people to come and do these jobs, especially cleaning after Masses, both on weekdays and weekends. It does not take

long if there are a few, but it can be tedious if you are the only one. Please check to see if there are enough people to clean up after Mass or if there are enough ushers. Let's see if people continue to return and the Masses stay full. If we are "overflowing" at Masses, let me know what you think we should do.

We began singing last weekend, though with masks on and at low intensity so as to keep from spreading germs. It was great to have you singing! The cantor and priest are a good 30 feet from anyone, so masks do not apply to them. I urge you to sign up and observe the protocols which have kept us from becoming a place where COVID-19 spreads: masking, physical distancing, and hand sanitizing. Please continue to pray that we do not have an outbreak here, especially in the school. We have taken a lot of precautions to make it a safe haven, but both the virus and children can be unpredictable.

This is a friendly reminder, hoping that we do not get too far behind in our plate offering: please remember to bring in, mail in, or give your offering electronically. Last year at this time we were about \$7,700 behind, this week we are \$33,600 behind. Fortunately we have some reserve to buffer us at this time, but the trend is not sustainable. If you are not able to give because you have lost your job or are in financial difficulty, then please don't worry about it. It is my hope that we as a community will be able to pull together and be stronger for having gone through the COVID-19 scare together.

Please let me know if there is something I or we can do to help you. It remains a great joy to be your pastor!


