

MISSION STATEMENT

"We, the community of St. Gregory Barbarigo, are called forth in Baptism to follow the mission of Jesus to teach, to love, and to serve."

Next week is the 1st Sunday of Advent. We will begin Year B on Sundays and so will emphasize the Gospel of Mark for most of the year instead of Matthew which we had this past Year A. This Advent there is only ONE day in the 4th Week of Advent, as Christmas comes on the following Monday. Not only will it seem to go fast, it will be shorter than normal. Mondays will be filled in the evenings during Advent. On Dec. 11th we will have a communal penance service with soup supper afterwards, 5:30 PM – 7 PM or until confessions are finished. There will be five confessors here. On Dec 4th and 11th I will present on "The Mass as the Perfect Sacrifice" from 6 – 7 PM. The topic is in keeping with the national focus on the Eucharistic Revival on the parish level this year.

The Diocese of Kansas City – St. Joseph is in the process of changing the normal age of Confirmation from 15 years old to 12 years old. We have about five or six years to move our program from the older to the younger model. I personally am supportive of this move. Why? Well, from a developmental perspective, it does not fit in where it is now. Let me explain.

Roughly speaking there are four stages of development:

- 1) From 0-6 years old when the children have an absorbent mind, are very tactile in how they learn, and often put a lot of things in their mouths. They seek physical and biological independence.
- 2) From 6-12 years old when the children are developing their minds, learning how and why things work, learning right from wrong, and seeking intellectual development.
- From 12-18 years old when adolescents learn to be socially independent. They have been learning all kinds of data and developing understanding of things, and now they are seeking to put the pieces of data together as if they were pieces of a puzzle. Though they still learn as in the previous two phases, they emphasize looking at things critically and figuring out how they fit together in their lives. Finally
- 4) From 18-24, when young people choose their careers, their spouses, their place in life socially. They seek moral and spiritual independence in this phase.

The age of Confirmation has been about 15 in our diocese for a while. Confirmation is a sacrament asking the recipient to make a decision for Christ, to become a "soldier of Christ" as we used to say, to dedicate oneself totally to the Lord by the reception of the Holy Spirit. It is a wonderful event. However, at 15 a young man or woman is more likely to be examining everything closely, analyzing how, in this case, religion fits into his/her life. Developmentally speaking, it is not a good time to be making a life commitment, to say that one is totally committed to Christ. That commitment should come either earlier in phase II, or later in phase IV. The diocese has chosen the former, putting Confirmation at the end of phase II.

Now, I must say that I do not know all the factors that went into the diocesan decision to move the age to 12 year olds. The above is just my own feeling about this. In the end, it does not matter, as we are going to move to the new model. We will be working on a process to get from where we are to where the diocese wants us to be – to have our youth Confirmed at an earlier age of 12.

It is a privilege to be your pastor.



so long ago when I sat in church feeling that everyone around me was holier, more perfect, or worthy than me.




