

The staff, Fr. Karl, and I would like to thank all of you for your generous gifts and cards over Christmas. You have been so kind in your thoughtfulness and generosity. THANK YOU! I also want to thank you for catching up our plate income over the Christmas holidays. We were getting behind on giving, and made it up over the holidays. Thank you again for your support of the parish and our apostolates.

This past Christmas break from Dec. 28th to Jan. 5th I spent in St. Louis doing the wedding of my God-daughter and then attending the SEEK Conference put on by FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) – 20,000 college students and about 600 priests and 50 bishops/cardinals at each Mass in the Dome in St. Louis. I came back exhausted, but happily so. Most of the college students went to confession and we priests took turns absolving them. I must say that this was an edifying experience – 2 days, 2 weeks, 2 months, most of them less than 6 months since their last confession. And there were lots of them, young adults working seriously on their spiritual lives. The talks were inspiring, the reactions of the students enthusiastic, the liturgies were beautiful. The only bad thing was that they shared their germs with me, and so I came back ill, but the same thing happens with the students in our school.

This past week was mostly postponed due to weather. The Master Planning Focus Meetings scheduled for last Tuesday have been re-scheduled for next Tuesday. Our architecture firm, SFS Architecture, INC., from Kansas City will come to listen to parish and school staff and teachers, members representing Liturgy, music, kitchen, athletics, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and Religious Education, high school and middle school youth groups, Art & Environment, Evangelization, Sacraments, and others about improvements in our physical plan so that we can come up with a Master Plan, then prioritize projects and figure out how much we can afford to do in the near future. Most of what we are planning has to do with the school, but there are things that affect the whole parish as well. The whole parish will be shown the results and given the opportunity to comment on and contribute to the results of our deliberations. So stay tuned! The Pastoral Council and Building Committee are working on this project. In case you want to contact someone to provide suggestions or input, members of the Pastoral Council and who they represent are: President, Charles Mayfield (Finance), Vice-President Ashley Greeley (PTO), Wayne Pierson (KofC), Russ Schuster (Evangelization/Welcoming), Traci Snyders (School Advisory Board), Tom Casteel (Maintenance), with *ex-officio* members: Fr. Albert, Fr. Karl (Liturgy), Angela Byers (Finance), and Karma Coleman (school). Members of the Building Committee are: Fr. Albert, Bill Ingles, Scott Kuhlemeyer, Sarah Kurz, Josh Lefeber, Dave Moore, Sheila Smail, Tom Spire, Michele Starke, Mark Wiederholt, and Martha Kauffman (diocese).

Please pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit on our deliberations. We want to put in place the resources and set the course for the future of our parish as we fashion our Master Plan. It is a joy to be your pastor!
