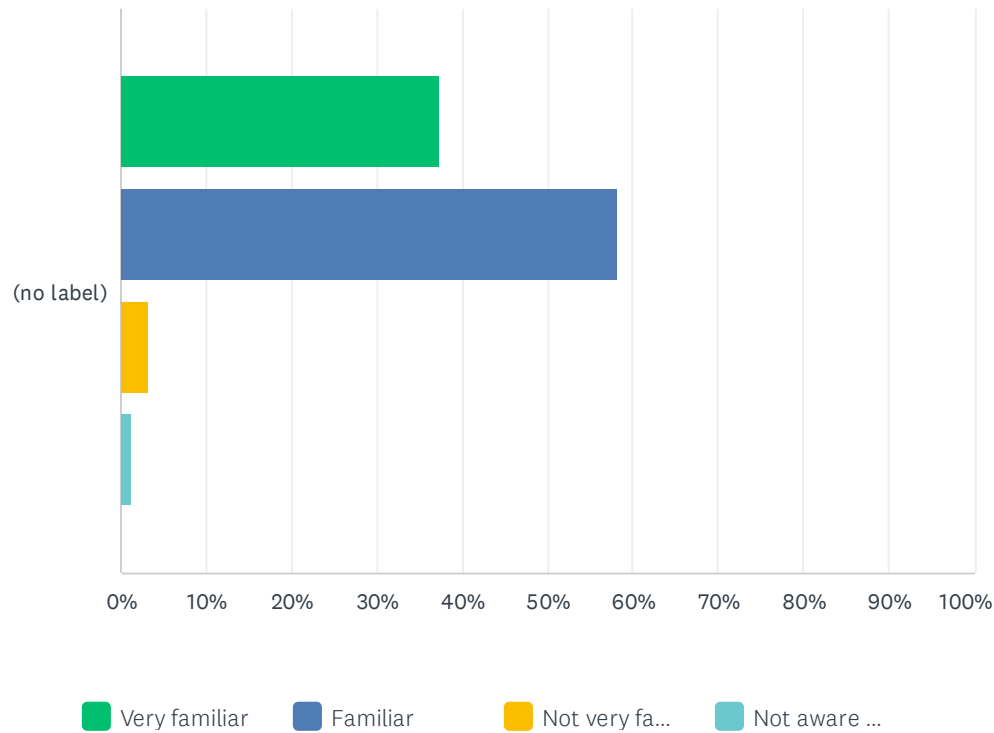


Q1 1. How familiar do you feel with St. Gregory’s capital campaign?

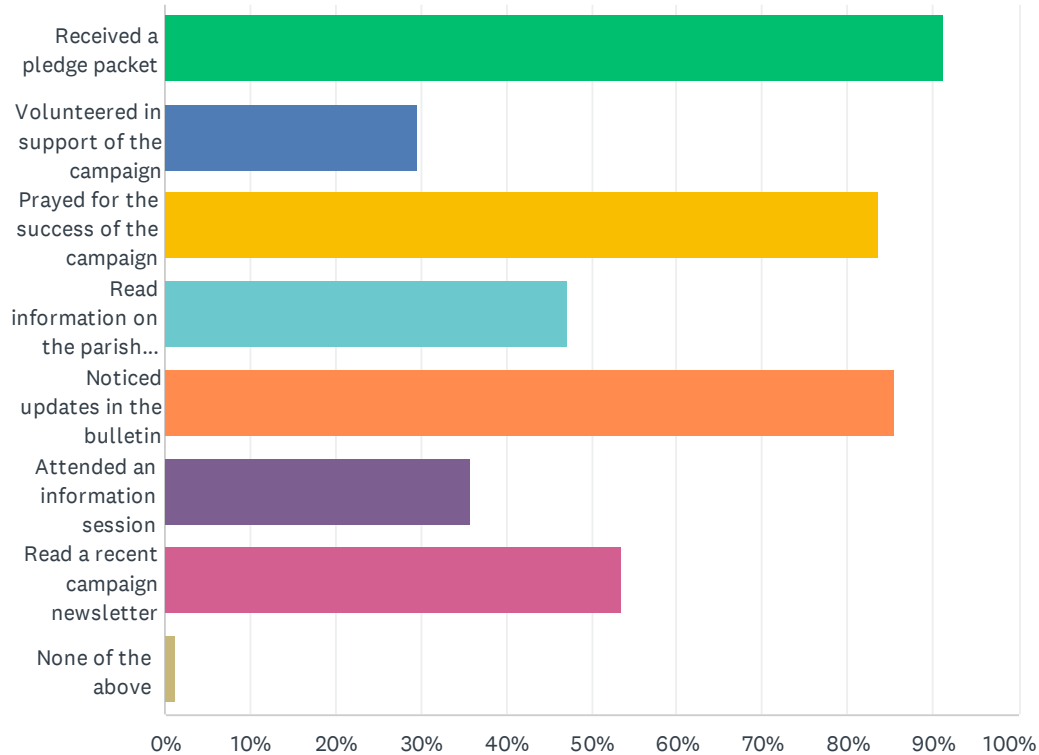

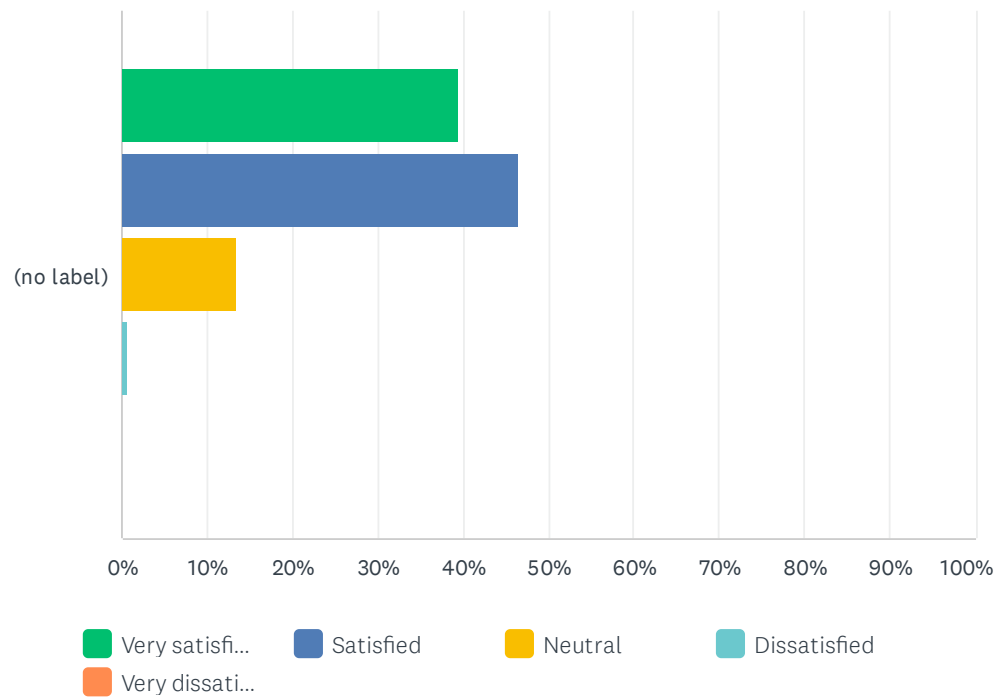

Q3 3. How satisfied are you with the communication about the capital campaign?

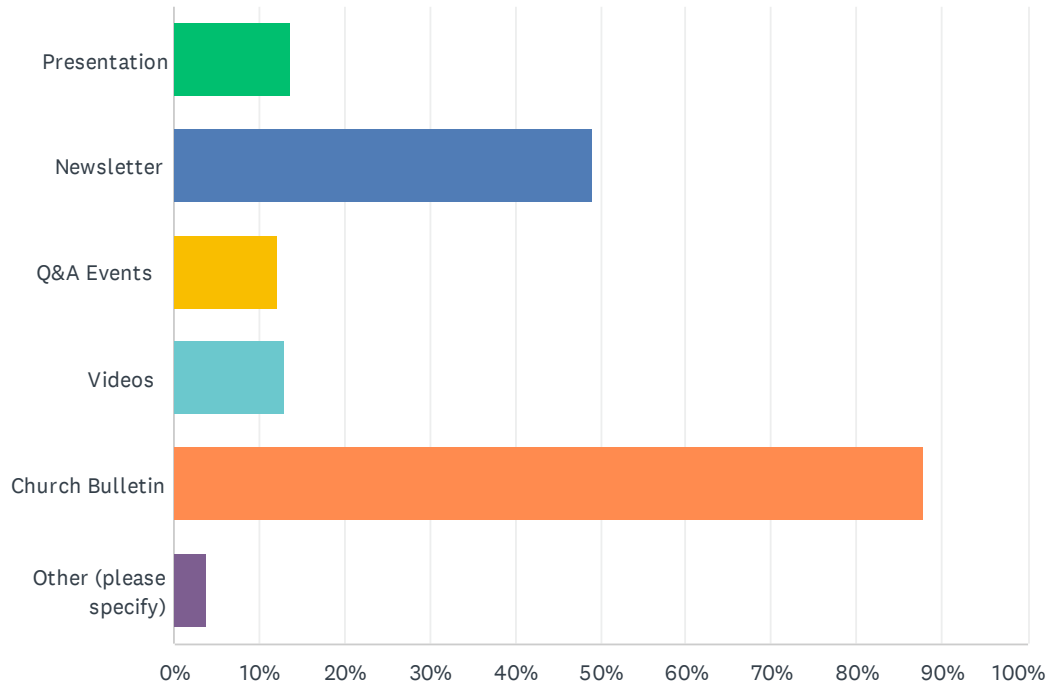

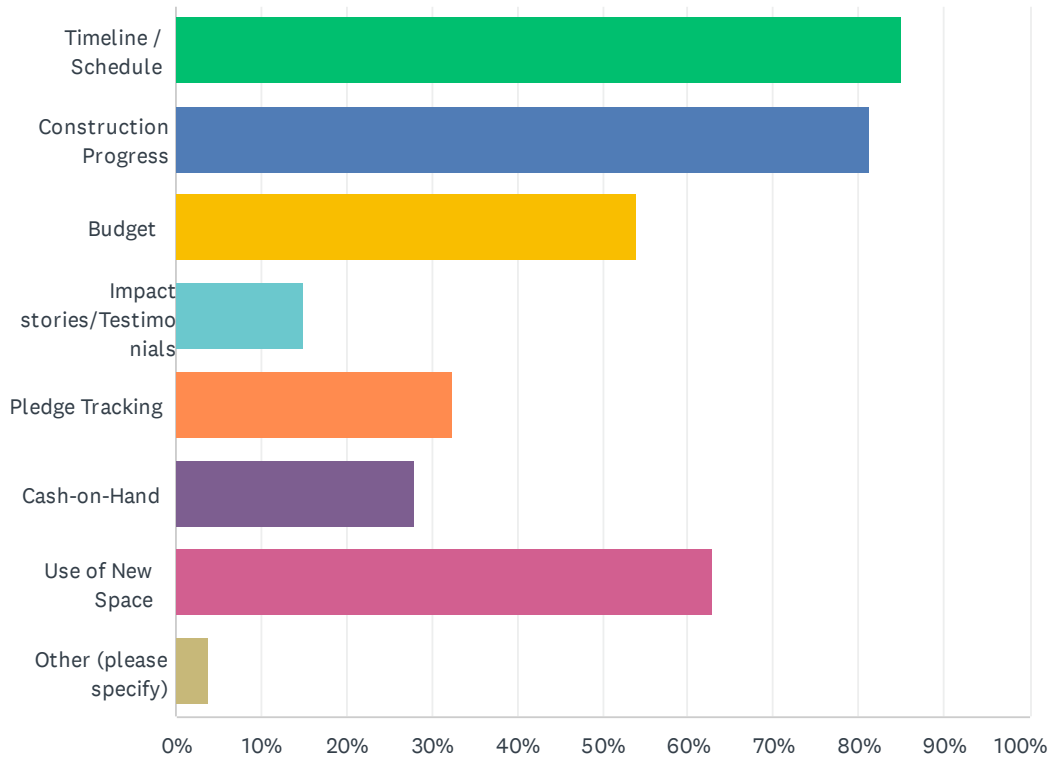

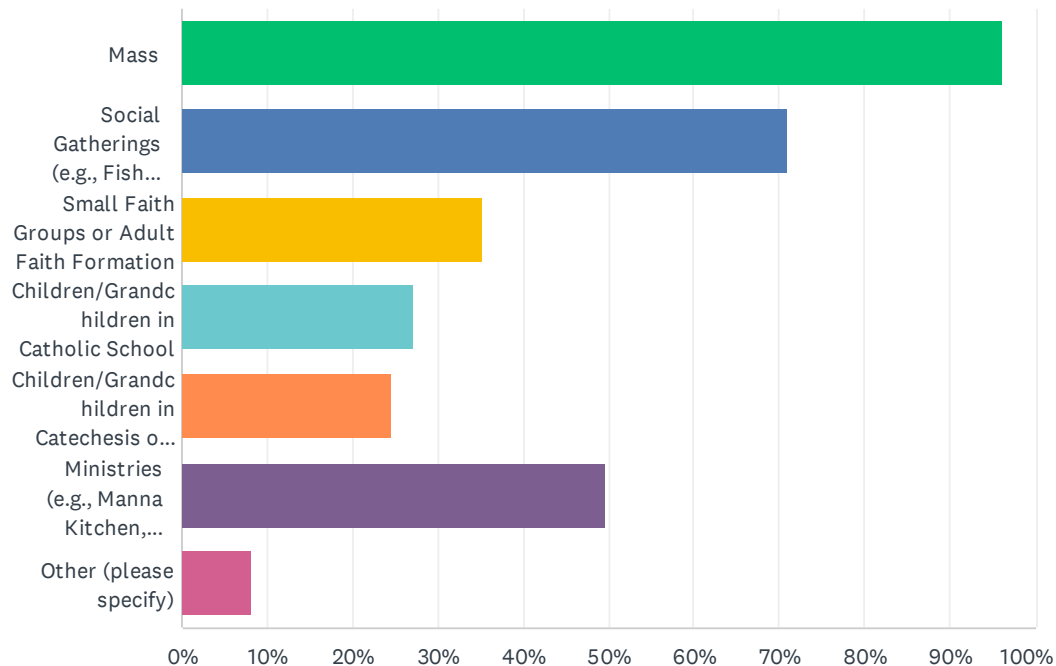

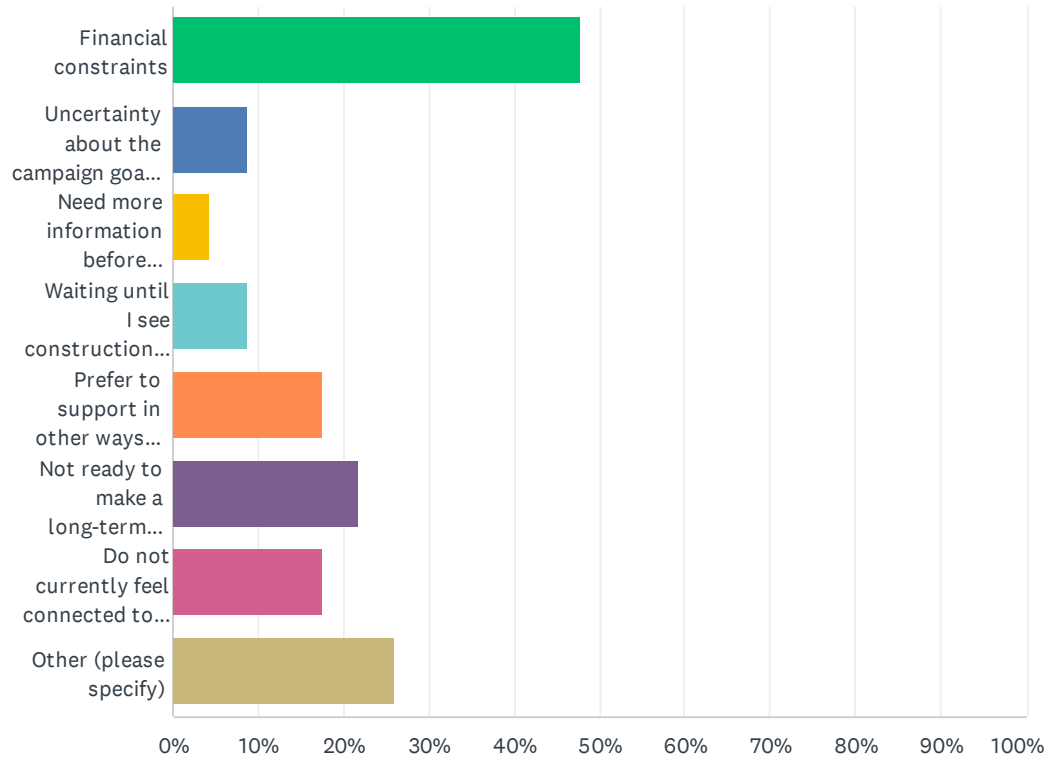

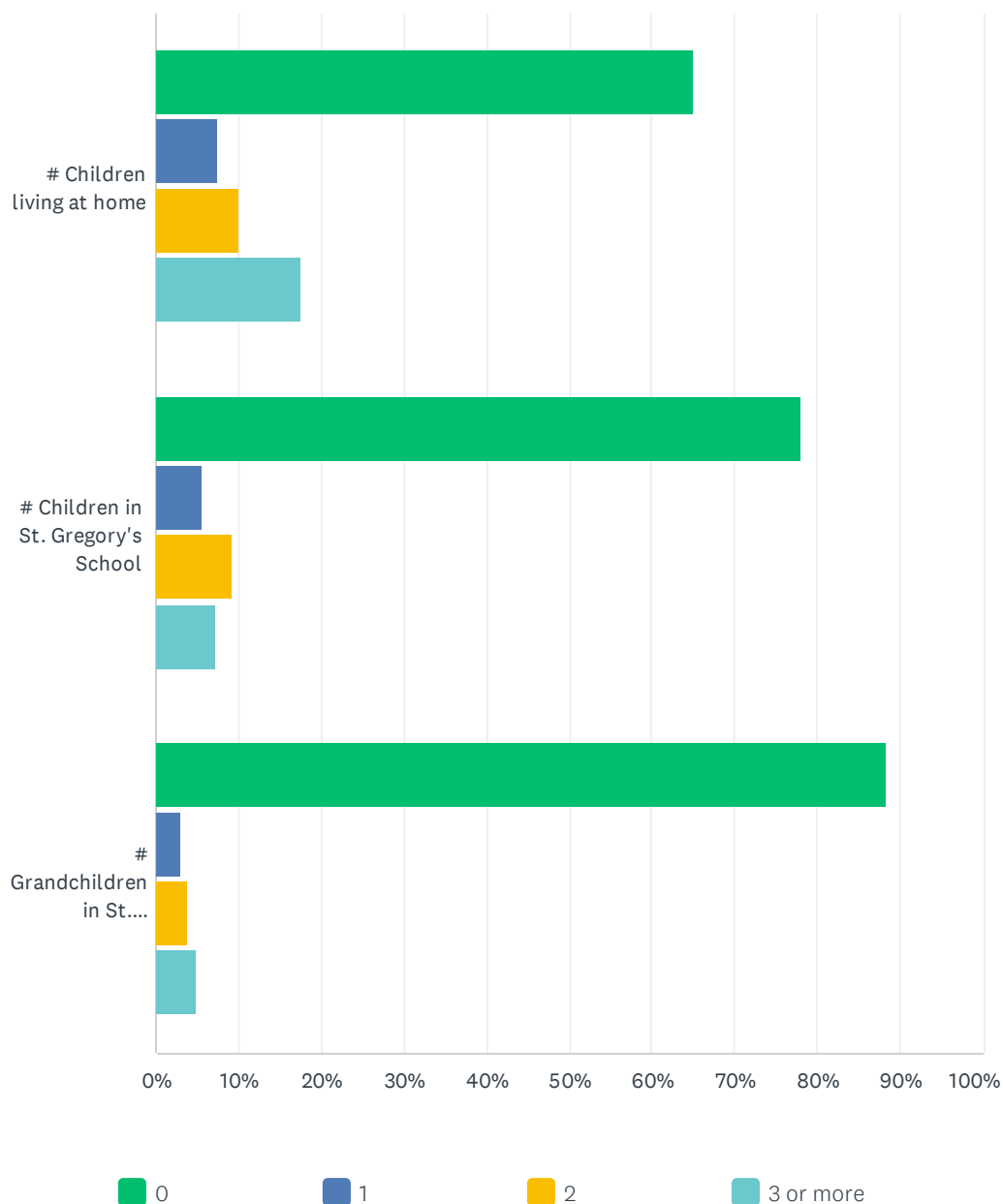

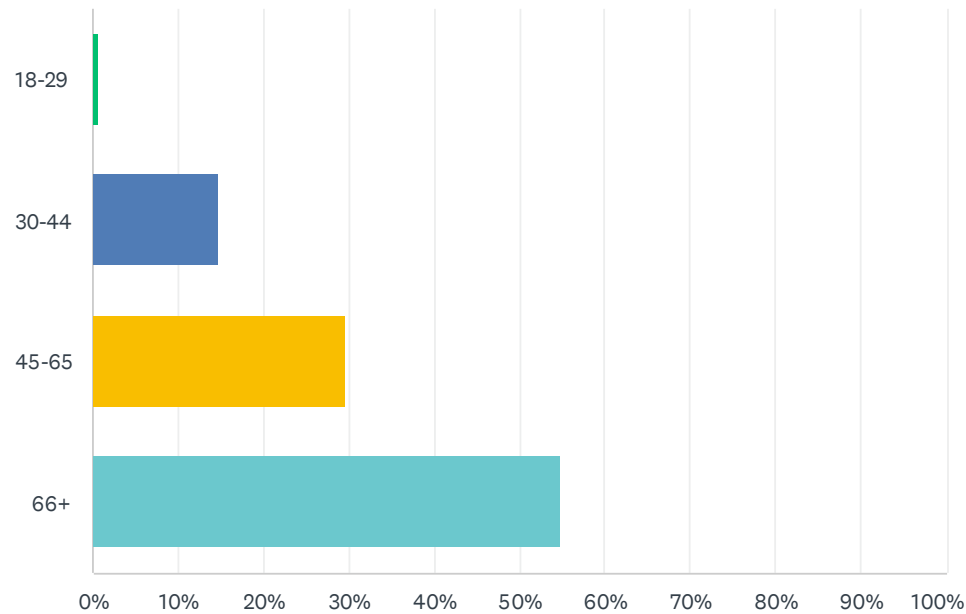

Q15 Age(s) of Household Heads

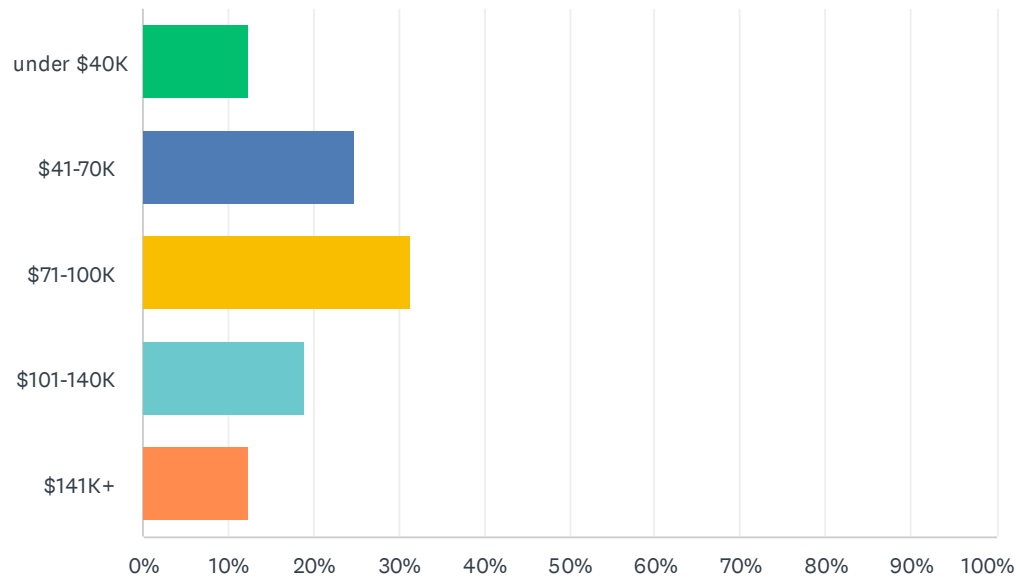
