From the desk of Fr. Mark

Today we offer glory and praise to our God as we celebrate the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Amen! It is a joy to move towards the end of the month as we open our hearts to celebrate the gifts God has given us to steward. I thank each of you for your support of Fr. Stanislaus through the Mission Co-Op appeal. His words were inspiring and full of God's blessings in the work his Diocese does in India. If you wish to give to the appeal, there are envelopes on the back tables of the church.

As we move forward towards the 66th Anniversary celebration on August 9 2025, we are reminded of the continual implementation of the pastoral plan of our Diocese of San Jose. Little seeds are being planted, and old plants are being pruned for the new life in our parish. A few weeks ago, I was pleasantly surprised when I walked by one of our meeting spaces and found our Social Concerns Committee having a meeting. New members and longtime members were meeting and sharing ideas in planning on how best this committee can grow to serve the surrounding community as Jesus commanded us to do in the Gospels. There are other small areas of growth that we often don't see but never-the-less are germinating in the fields of the Lord ready to sprout forth in abundance.

"The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." (Mt 9:37-38) We continue to encourage all members of the community to ask how best can we use our time and talent to become laborers in the vineyard of the Lord.

Our parish school begins classes in just three short weeks on August 20th. It is a great blessing to have a Catholic School at our parish. We have begun a Dual Language Immersion program where our students learn in both English and Spanish during the school day. Dual Language Immersion helps students grow and think in different and creative ways that helps them achieve and learn to be great students and children of God. There are fliers in the back of the Church where you can help classrooms have the necessary supplies for the upcoming year. Hay otras pequeñas áreas de crecimiento que a menudo no vemos, pero que, sin embargo, están germinando en los campos del Señor, listas para brotar en abundancia. ***«La mies es mucha, pero los obreros pocos; rogad, pues, al dueño de la mies que envíe obreros a su mies»*** (Mt 9,37-38). Palabra que da La Vida

¡Pídele con humildad!

“Así os digo a vosotros: Pedid y se os dará, buscad y hallaréis, llamad y se os abrirá; porque quien pide recibe, quien busca halla y al que llama se le abre. ¿Qué padre entre vosotros, cuando el hijo le pide pan, le dará una piedra?» (Lc 11, 9-13)

La “palabra de vida” de esta semana nos invita a ser humildes ante el Señor y a acudir a Él mostrándole nuestras necesidades. Cristo nos anima a pedir y nos recuerda que Dios es amor y que está siempre con los oídos abiertos para escuchar nuestras súplicas.

Sin embargo, hay algunos “peros”. El primero está en la propia esencia de la petición. Pedir significa rogar, no exigir. Y nosotros no sabemos, por lo general, pedir. **El que pide no se enfada si no se le concede lo pedido, pues sabe que está suplicando algo a lo que no tiene derecho. Los favores se solicitan, no se reclaman.** En cambio, nosotros, aunque parezca que pedimos, en realidad lo que hacemos es exigir, como demuestra nuestro comportamiento cuando no nos dan lo que hemos pedido: enfados, alejamiento de Dios, incluso chantajes y pérdida de la fe. ¿No será que Dios no te lo concedió porque pedías mal, porque, quizá sin darte tú cuenta, más que pedir exigías?

El segundo inconveniente está en que sólo pedimos cosas materiales. ¿Cómo debe sentirse Dios ante este comportamiento nuestro? ¿No estaría mucho más dispuesto a ayudarnos si viera que lo que nos preocupa por encima de todo es la santidad? ¿Y si probáramos a pedirle con la misma insistencia tanto el amor a Él y al prójimo como el resto de los favores que suplicamos para nosotros o para los nuestros?

Por último, el que el Señor nos anime a pedir no significa que sólo debamos pedir. Sin agradecimiento, la petición se vuelve egoísmo y cansa a aquel al que se le está pidiendo ayuda.

Propósito: Pedir con humildad, diciéndole a Dios que si no nos lo concede no pasa nada. Pedir la santidad, es decir, el estar enamorado de Dios. Agradecer por todo lo que tenemos y ofrecernos.

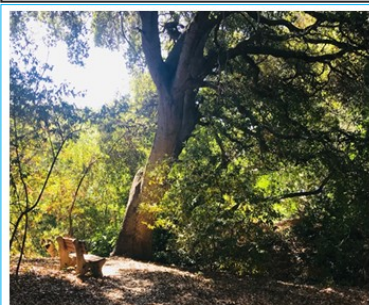
Persistence in Prayer

(taken from Commentary on the First Reading and the Gospel)

Persistence in prayer is the theme of today's readings. There is an amazing contrast between the ominous opening monologue and the entertaining and colorful dialogue that follow in today's First Reading. We learn that the sin of these cities cries to heaven for vengeance. That God allows Abraham to bargain and set ever-lower conditions for action against the cities makes their exchange all the more remarkable. It is no small matter over which God is willing to show mercy "if there are at least ten there." Abraham's familiar attitude with God is understandable given the lavish meal he earlier prepared for God and given the ancient Near Eastern belief that the servant of a god or king was also a friend.

Jesus taught best by his example. In today's Gospel he teaches prayer that way. The disciples observe Jesus at prayer and ask him to teach them how to pray. There are three units to this Gospel passage, and each could be proclaimed independently of the others. "Father is the bond that connects the first section to the third. The intervening parable humorously illustrates the primary message of today's readings: we should expect God to hear and answer prayer, but we must also persevere. Jesus' illustrative parable is as colorful as and even more animated than Abraham's dialogue with God in the First Reading. In the Greek, the expression "I tell you" implies "I personally tell you...." The time spent and examples offered indicate this topic is of great importance to Jesus. Despite his definitive statements, Jesus is not endorsing a fundamentalist approach to prayer, nor suggesting we can magically control God with our intercessions. No. The words of the "Our Father" still echo in our ears reminding us that we must "seek" and "find" only those things that conform with God's will – glorification of God's name, the coming of the kingdom, forgiveness, and being spared the final test.

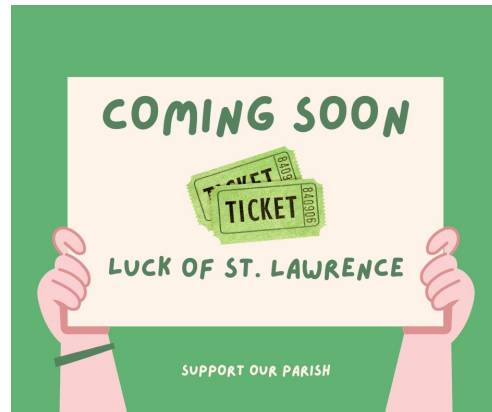
