From the desk of Fr. Mark

O Come, O Come Emanuel! is the joyous verse we sing as we begin the twenty-six days of our Advent journey. It is a time of preparation where we purify our mind, body, and soul in preparation in receiving the new born King, Jesus the Christ.

This Advent season, we have received a small reflection booklet to help us navigate our work through this time and the Christmas season. The reflection that we will read in a couple of days (from December 2nd) reminds us of our call to childlike simplicity. The joy, trust, and innocence are alluding us to joy and wonder. What does this joy and wonder look like in my life as a man, sixty-four years old?

Friday December 5th join us at our Parish School's Christmas Concert

- Every Wednesday we offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- December 10th - Advent Reconciliation from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. Bilingual service.
- December 8th - The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception
- December 9th - The presentation of the Apparitions of Our Lady of Guadalupe
- December 12th - The Celebration of the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe
- Beginning December 15th the Novena of Sambang Gabi

We will have a full list of the Parish's Advent Activities so you can post it at home for reference in the coming weeks.

We will also be bringing back our 3-minute catechesis to talk about and encourage us to pray with the Advent booklet, as well as a daily reflection that will be found on the website, sharing Fr. Mark's thoughts on the joy and wonder of his Advent journey.

Most importantly, Advent is a time to allow our hearts to be filled with the love of waiting patiently. To allow the new born King to find a heart ready for the experience of new life, new hope, and the wonder that comes from love.

LITURGY CORNER

The cycle of the Catholic Lectionary in the United States is three years in length, with the three so-called synoptic Gospels comprising the bulk of the readings during each three-year cycle: Matthew in Year A (the year we are starting on this the first Sunday of Advent), Mark in Year B, and Luke in Year C. During all three years, we find the Gospel of John on specified feast days and solemnities. In 2026, we will have the readings from Year A and the Gospel readings will be the Gospel of Matthew. By tradition, Matthew the evangelist has usually been identified with Matthew the tax collector, whose call to discipleship we find in Matthew 9:9:

“As Jesus passed on from there, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the customs post. He said to him, ‘Follow me.’ And he got up and followed him.”

Matthew later lists one “Matthew the tax collector” among the twelve apostles (Matthew 10:3). Mark and Luke also include a Matthew among the original twelve, but offer no other details (Mark 3:18, Luke 6:15; see also Acts 1:13). It is also true, however, that the author of Matthew never identifies himself within the text of the Gospel. Additionally, the Gospel was probably written in the latter decades of the first century AD when Jesus’ disciples would have been, at best, very old men. Whatever the case, it seems that whoever wrote this Gospel held Matthew and his fellow apostles in high esteem.

Jesus’ fulfillment of Jewish scripture is a persistent theme in all four Gospels, although it has a special prominence in Matthew. Repeatedly, we read that something Jesus does, or something happening to him, fulfills scripture.

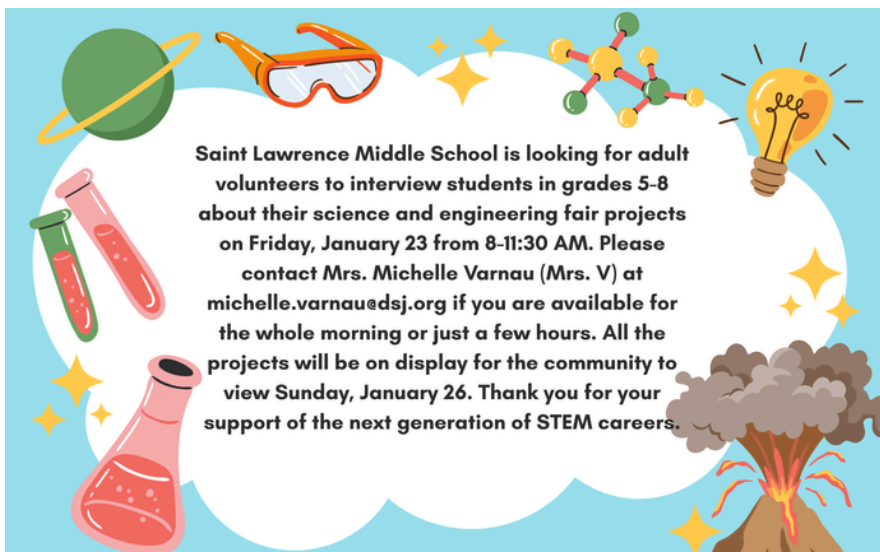

No habría sacrificio físico que despreciase, ni esfuerzo que no afrontase; no me importaría lo temprano que tuviese que sonar el despertador o la paciencia que tuviese que emplear con mi jefe. ¿Y por ti, Señor? ¿Es que no vales tú más que eso? ¿Es que tu amistad no tiene un valor mayor que el dinero? ¿Quién estaba a mi lado cuando me fallaron los amigos? ¿Quién estará cuando me llegue la muerte? ¿Quién ha hecho por mí tan solo una pequeña parte de lo que has hecho tú?

Cristo necesita que le quieras por él mismo y está esperando que le acojas como el mejor invitado.

Propósito: Prepararnos para acoger a Cristo en nuestra vida con un buen examen de conciencia, para descubrir qué hemos hecho mal e intentar corregirlo. Rezar y participar más en la santa misa.

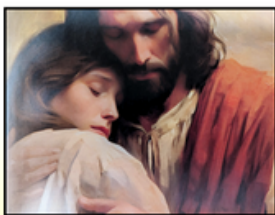
