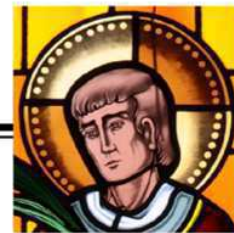

A Message from Fr. Mark / Un Mensaje del Padre Mark



Merry Christmas to everyone. Today we are celebrating the Feast of the Holy Family during the Octave of Christmas. As Catholics we now spend the next eight days celebrating the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ until the Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God and then come to an end of the Christmas season with the celebration of the Epiphany of the Lord this coming Sunday January 4th.

We are reminded that Christmas does not end on the 25th of December but as a time to celebrate and enjoy the Christmas joy for the 12 days that follow and the giving of gifts can continue as we share the Christmas joy.

As we celebrate the Holy Family we focus on the blessing of family in our lives. We acknowledge how our families will never be like the Jesus, Mary and Joseph triad of perfect love, but we are called to strive to be the best and holiest family in our relationships of love.

Pope St. John Paul II reminded us "Family prayer has its own characteristic qualities. It is prayer offered in common, husband and wife together, parents and children together...by reason of their dignity and mission, Christian parents have the specific responsibility of educating their children in prayer, introducing them to gradual discovery of the mystery of God and to personal dialogue with Him..." (#59-60 Familiaris Consortio: The Role of the Christian Family in the Modern World) When husband and wife enter into the sacramental unity (the two shall become one) they become a living prayer in the world. They witness to the reality of a love that goes beyond the mundane and becomes a sacrificial gift in the image of Jesus Christ. The education of the children then is accomplished through the living witness of their love as they live the dignity of the gifts given and shared.

Pope Francis then continues "We need simplicity to pray as a family: simplicity is necessary! Praying the Our Father together, around the table, is not something extraordinary: it's easy. And praying the rosary together as a family is very beautiful and a source of great strength!" (Pope Francis Mass for the Family Oct 27, 2013) As husband and wife become a living prayer, families can, like the Holy Family, practice in becoming the living prayer in the world. That is our hope!

Lastly, on Christmas day we received the book *Slowing Down To The Speed of Joy*. We will talk more about that in the New Year. Please take your time... slow down...rediscover Joy.

Feliz Navidad a todos. Hoy celebramos la Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia durante la octava de Navidad. Como católicos, ahora pasamos los próximos ocho días celebrando el nacimiento de nuestro Señor Jesucristo hasta la Solemnidad de María, Santa Madre de Dios, y luego llegamos al final de la temporada navideña con la celebración de la Epifanía del Señor este próximo domingo 4 de enero.

Se nos recuerda que la Navidad no termina el 25 de diciembre, sino que es un momento para celebrar y disfrutar de la alegría navideña durante los 12 días siguientes, y que el regalo puede continuar mientras compartimos la alegría navideña.

Al celebrar la Sagrada Familia, nos centramos en la bendición de la familia en nuestras vidas. Reconocemos que nuestras familias nunca serán como la tríada de amor perfecto de Jesús, María y José, pero estamos llamados a esforzarnos por ser la mejor y más santa familia en nuestras relaciones de amor.

El Papa San Juan Pablo II nos recordó: "La oración familiar tiene sus propias cualidades características. Es una oración ofrecida en común, marido y mujer juntos, padres e hijos juntos... por razón de su dignidad y misión, los padres cristianos tienen la responsabilidad específica de educar a sus hijos en la oración, introduciéndoles en el descubrimiento gradual del misterio de Dios y en el diálogo personal con Él..." (#59-60 Familiaris Consortio: El papel de la familia cristiana en el mundo moderno) Cuando marido y mujer entran en la unidad sacramental (los dos se convertirán en uno) se convierten en una oración viva en el mundo. Son testigos de la realidad de un amor que va más allá de lo mundano y se convierte en un regalo sacrificial a imagen de Jesucristo. La educación de los niños se logra entonces a través del testimonio vivo de su amor, mientras viven la dignidad de los dones dados y compartidos.

El Papa Francisco continúa: "Necesitamos simplicidad para orar en familia: ¡la simplicidad es necesaria! Rezar juntos al Padre Nuestro, alrededor de la mesa, no es algo extraordinario: es fácil. ¡Y rezar el rosario juntos como familia es muy bonito y una fuente de gran fortaleza!" (Misa del Papa Francisco para la Familia 27 de octubre de 2013) A medida que marido y mujer se convierten en una oración viva, las familias pueden, como la Sagrada Familia, practicar para convertirse en la oración viva del mundo. ¡Esa es nuestra esperanza!

Por último, el día de Navidad recibimos el libro *Ralentizando hasta la velocidad de la alegría*. Hablaremos más de eso en el Año Nuevo. Por favor, tómate tu tiempo... Tranquilo... redescubrir a Joy.

Feast of the Holy Family

(taken from The Little Blue book of Reflections on Advent)

In today's gospel we hear Matthew's account of what happened after the Magi departed. Joseph again receives information from an angel in a dream, "Rise, take child and his mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you. Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him."

It seems a strange phrase: "Search for the child to destroy him." Matthew is giving us a preview of the Passion when exactly the same word is used: The chief priest and the elders persuaded the crowds to ask for Barabbas but to destroy Jesus.

There is a tone of haste in the angel's message to Joseph. He had to hurry to escape Herod's search-and-destroy mission. Just honored with gifts, Jesus is about to be humiliated by flight.

The Holy Family heads for Egypt. It was outside Herod's jurisdiction, and a frequent haven for Jewish people fleeing his disfavor.

Joseph is back in a familiar role: He is told what has to be done, and he does it. The whole future is not revealed to him, just what has to be done now.

We might muse..."I wish I had an angel to tell me exactly what to do. I'd do it to the letter."

Well, maybe. On the other hand...there are times when we know exactly what we ought to do and then we don't do it. Maybe we should talk to Joseph about that.

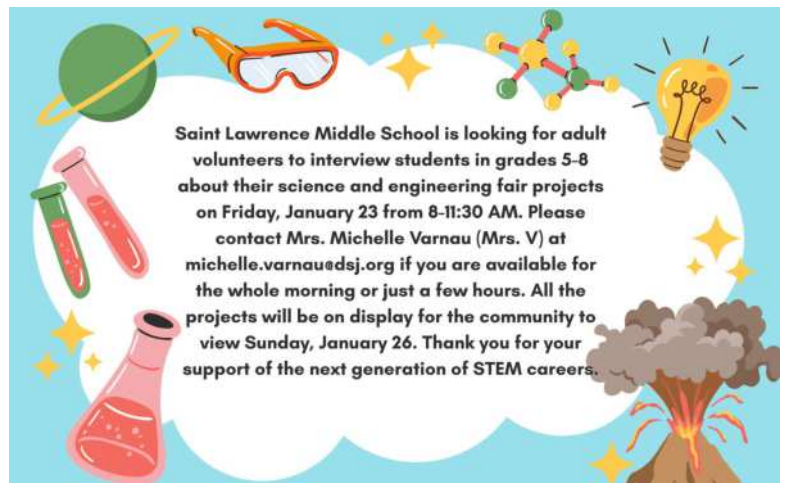
"Coventry Carol is a 16th-century carol, commemorating Matthew's account of the tragic slaughter of innocent infant boys during the time of King Herod. The song was originally featured in "The Pageant of the Shearmen and Tailors," a religious drama based on the biblical story beginning with the Annunciation and ending with the massacre of the baby boys. The carol is the sorrowful lament of a mother trying to lull her baby to "be still" so that Herod's soldiers will not find and kill him. These religious dramas were called "mystery plays", and were particularly popular during the Middle Ages. "Coventry Carol" is named after the English village where the mystery play was performed. December 28th is the Feast of the Holy Innocents.

Palabra que da La Vida

"Levántate y toma al niño y a su madre y huye a Egipto y estate allí hasta que yo te lo diga, porque ha de acontecer que Herodes busque al niño para matarle." (Mt 2, 13-15)

La fiesta de la Sagrada Familia, que la Iglesia siempre sitúa en el primer domingo después de la Navidad, nos invita a reflexionar sobre la vida familiar que cada uno está llevando, entendiendo por familia también a los ancianos y a los tíos, y no sólo a los propios hijos o a los esposos. En este caso, el texto elegido por la Iglesia es el de la huida a Egipto y, por lo tanto, nuestra meditación y nuestra práctica debe ir dirigida a ver qué situaciones de peligro hay para nuestra familia en particular y para la familia en general.

Todos sabemos que hoy la familia atraviesa una gran crisis, con muchos problemas derivados de la incertidumbre acerca de cuál es el papel que deben jugar los padres, cuál el de los hijos y cuáles son los límites de los derechos de unos y de otros. No es fácil la convivencia y por eso son cada vez más el número de familias rotas. Por eso, el objetivo de esta semana es el de construir o reforzar las relaciones de amor partiendo del respeto a los derechos del otro sin que eso signifique abdicar de los derechos propios. Para ello conviene conjugar dos principios básicos. El primero es el de que toda convivencia implica sacrificio, aunque también lleva aneja la existencia de buenos momentos; no se puede pretender vivir en familia sin amor y no se puede pretender amar sin aceptar la cruz; además, si se elige no vivir en familia, hay que tener en cuenta que también ahí hay sacrificios, el de la soledad, por ejemplo. El segundo principio es el de que todo tiene un límite y cuando ese límite se sobrepasa se pueden recurrir a medidas extraordinarias que la Iglesia permite; pero hasta llegar a ese límite normalmente hay un largo camino que hay que recorrer, con paciencia, con generosidad, con inteligencia.

Propósito: Hacer todo lo posible para que reine la armonía en la propia familia y también luchar para que la familia en general sea defendida por las leyes civiles.
