

PREP PROGRAM 2017

Applications are now available to middle school students for the summer PREP program. PREP is a mathematics-based, academic enrichment program, emphasizing the development of abstract reasoning and problem solving skills. The program helps students prepare for careers in the fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). The program includes course work, team projects, class presentations, examinations, career awareness speakers, field trips, and special events. PREP classes will be held Monday through Thursday, beginning June 12 and ending July 27, 2017, on local college campuses. A maximum of three excused absences is allowed.

Interested Year 1 students may pick up an application packet from their science or math teacher, or the counseling office. The Year 1 application is also available to be downloaded or completed online at www.prep-usa.org. All applicants must submit the required teacher nomination forms, a copy of the most recent report card, and a 100-200 word essay on "Why I want to attend PREP". If submitting online, a confirmation page must be printed and signed. Application deadline is January 31, 2017. See flyer for more details.
