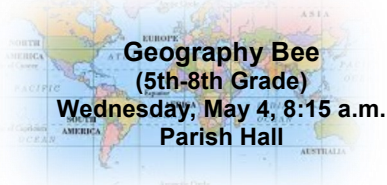

## May Crowning

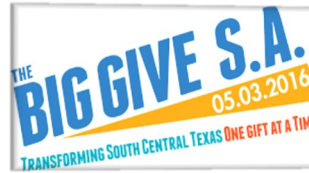
The annual May Crowning Mass will be celebrated on Thursday, May 5. As in the past, we are asking each student to bring in one flower in honor of our Blessed Mother.

BLESSED MOTHER TERESA

Seventh and eighth grade students from the Blessed Mother Teresa Society led the school liturgy on Thursday, April 21. Following Communion, students reenacted the ceremony at which Blessed Mother Teresa was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1979. The St. Luke Blessed Mother Teresa Society recognizes middle school students who have made service to others a significant part of their lives. Students who have gone far above the required number of service hours and complete an application are received into the Blessed Mother Teresa Society at the end of the school year and at graduation.
