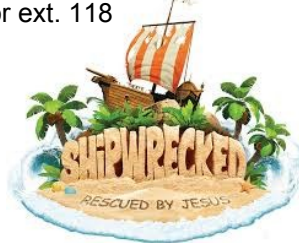
Summer Learning Program Registration Ends Soon Entering 1st-4th Grade

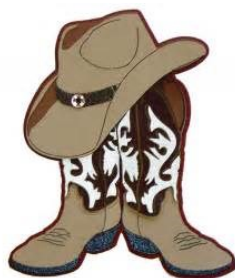
