On-Line Re-registration

Dear Parents,

To complete our online reenrollment process, you will access our ParentsWeb through your existing login. If you do not have a login, please follow the instructions for <u>creating a ParentsWeb without an existing login</u> listed below.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Only re-register your <u>oldest</u> (only) child. You will be billed on FACTS for multiple children/siblings for registration as in the past.
- If any of the children in your family are not returning, please let the school office know by email. At the time of registration, you will pay a registration fee of \$275.00 (plus \$10 Facts/Renweb Fee) for the first student and then billed for the difference through your FACTS tuition account if you have multiple children. You will receive an email notification from FACTS when this charge has been added to your FACTS tuition account (\$50 per each additional student in the family).
- After completing your oldest/only child's enrollment, click on the FACTS link and select your payment plan for 2019-2020.

To re-enroll a student and access ParentsWeb with an existing login:

Please go to www.renweb.com

- Select **Logins** from the menu bar and **ParentsWeb Login** from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.
- After logging in, click on the **Family Information** button in the left menu.
- Click on the **Enrollment/Reenrollment** button.

Our Online Enrollment system will open with a link to the enrollment packet for Your Student.

The online process should take approximately 15 minutes to complete.

Your information will be saved if you need to guit and come back later.

The Instructions and Enrollment Checklist page of the enrollment packet contains supplemental enrollment forms that also must be submitted.

This registration needs to be completed in full to be considered registered and to be placed on a class roster.

At the time of registration, you will pay a registration fee of \$275.00 (plus the \$10 Facts/RenWeb Fee) for the first student and then billed for the difference if you have multiple children.

Creating a ParentsWeb (i.e., you have never logged in to RenWeb (now called FACTS SIS):

Please go to www.renweb.com.

- Select **Logins** from the menu bar and **ParentsWeb Login** from the drop-down menu.
- After the RenWeb ParentsWeb Login screen opens, please select Create New ParentsWeb Account.
- Enter **SLK-TX** into the District Code field.
- Enter in the Email field your email address as provided in your application to the school.
- Click the Create Account button.
- You will receive an email from RenWeb Customer Support containing a link that will allow you to create your username and password. For security purposes the link will remain active for 6 hours.
- Please click on the link. A Change/Create Password screen will open. You may use the default username provided, or create a new username. Then type in your desired password into the Password field and Confirm Field.
- Click on the Save Username and/or Password button.
- Close the window.

Log into ParentsWeb as instructed above.
