- ☐ Set of classic-colored wide or thin markers
- ☐ Colored pencils (sharpened ahead of time please)
- ☐ 2 packages of LOW ODOR dry erase markers (thick is preferred; no yellow if possible)
- ☐ One eraser for dry erase board
- ☐ Watercolor paints (16 colors) with brush(es) if needed
- ☐ 3 Sharpie black permanent markers
- ☐ Pointed pair of Fiskars scissors
- ☐ 2 pink pearl erasers (1 for the desk box/pouch; one in cubby shoebox storage)
- ☐ 10-15 glue sticks (a variety of school and all-purpose glue sticks please)
- ☐ 2 bottles of liquid Elmer's glue (1 school and 1 all-purpose)
- ☐ 30 sharpened No. 2 Ticonderoga pencils with eraser (Please no mechanical pencils)
- ☐ Small pencil sharpener with receptacle
- ☐ Erasable pens ONLY (prefer PILOT Frixion in assorted colors—or not at all; students can use pencils otherwise)
- ☐ 3-6 highlighters in a variety of colors
- ☐ 1 sturdy ruler with inches and centimeters
- ☐ 3 Post-it-Notes pads (any color--3" x 3")
- ☐ 1 clipboard clearly marked with the student's name on the back
- ☐ 1 PeeChee-type folder with bottom pockets (homework folder)
- ☐ 2 packages of loose leaf paper (wide or college-rule)
- ☐ 6 large (biggest size possible) spirals notebook

- ☐ 1 black marble-type wide ruled composition book with lines, not graph paper
- ☐ 1 red 3-hole plastic report cover
- ☐ 2 plastic report covers (any colors)
- ☐ Students will need 2 tri-fold display boards during the year—keep at home until needed
  - ☐ Medium 26" x 37" (approx.) for saints fair in the fall
  - ☐ Large 36" x 48" (approx.) for the science fair in the spring

### **Grades 6-8:**

- ☐ 1 package of college-ruled loose leaf paper
- ☐ 1 6-10 quart container/tub with lid to store personal school supplies
- ☐ 1 large pencil pouch
- ☐ 3 dozen pencils, at least, and a handheld pencil sharpener. If you choose mechanical, YOU are responsible for bringing lead.
- ☐ 3 large erasers (Pentel white ones are nice!)
- ☐ 2 boxes colored pencils
- ☐ Highlighters – 5 different colors
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Inexpensive wired earbuds to stay at school (No Air Pods)
- ☐ 1 clear 12" ruler with centimeter markings
- ☐ 12-24 count Crayola brand colored markers
- ☐ 20 glue sticks
- ☐ 1 package of 100 3x5" notecards
- ☐ 1 red 2-pocket folder (NEEDS to last all year)
- ☐ English and History:
  - ☐ 1 5-subject, green, lined spiral notebook with at least two built-in pockets. This will be used all year for English and History, so buy the big one.
  - ☐ **6th:** 3 college-rule composition notebooks for returning students, 4 for new students, 80-100 pages
  - ☐ **7th and 8th:** 4 college-rule composition notebooks with 80-100 pages.
  - ☐ **7th and 8th only:** The older students will be practicing annotating a book length story, and will need a personal copy of one of the books that we read as a class later in the year. With plenty of advance notice, we will send detailed information about what paperback to buy so that everyone has editions with the same page numbering.
  - ☐ A 8x10 sketchbook for nature journaling will be purchased for you, at bulk pricing, and \$5 will be charged to your FACTS account.
- ☐ Math:
  - ☐ 1 black spiral notebook (recommended 120 pages, instead of 70, plastic cover if possible)
  - ☐ 1 package of 1/4" graph paper
  - ☐ extra pencils

- ☐ TI-30 calculator (7th grade advanced math and all 8th graders should **consider** purchasing a TI-84 graphing calculator since this will be needed in high school and would be useful in 8th grade.)
- ☐ Science: 1 blue spiral notebook with built-in front pocket, 1-2 pockets
- ☐ Spanish/Religion: 1 red 5-subject spiral notebook with built-in front pocket
  - ☐ \$1.25 will be charged to your FATCS account for 1 tri-fold display board for saints fair in the fall. They have been purchased in bulk.
- ☐ Music: All students in **grades 6-7** will need a blue three-prong plastic folder, and a red 1-inch binder. Returning students may use their old one, so long as it is in good shape. All **grade 8** students will need a black plastic, three-prong folder.
- ☐ For Homework (To Be Kept at Home):
  - ☐ loose leaf notebook paper
  - ☐ plain printer paper
  - ☐ Glue
  - ☐ Scissors
  - ☐ Ruler
  - ☐ colored pencils
  - ☐ Pens
  - ☐ Crayons
  - ☐ Students should have access to the internet and a device that allows them to type, print (if possible), research, and watch math videos.
  - ☐ **World atlas** and a **printed dictionary**
  - ☐ Something similar to the *National Geographic Kids World Atlas* that includes political and physical maps. Online dictionaries are handy in a pinch, but using a paper dictionary makes students practice word analysis skills and reasoning. The Merriam-Webster Intermediate or Collegiate dictionaries, or something similar, are about \$20 new and widely available as used copies.

All CTK students will need to bring an Emergency/Earthquake Kit with them by the first day of instruction. All items will need to fit in a gallon sized Ziploc bag. Please label the bag with your child's name and grade level. The kit will be kept on campus for the duration of the school year and will be returned on the last day of school. Thank you!
