## AI expert, former Google China president Kai-Fu Lee to be honored in Oak Ridge on Monday

**OAK RIDGE** —Dr. Kai-Fu Lee, a world-leading artificial intelligence expert, billion-dollar venture capitalist, bestselling author, and former president of Google China, will be visiting his middle school alma mater, St. Mary Catholic School at 327 Vermont Ave., Oak Ridge, on Monday, May 6. In his autobiography and in interviews, Dr. Lee has voiced that he owes much of who he is today to the community he found at St. Mary Catholic School.

Dr. Lee has held executive positions with Apple, Microsoft, Silicon Graphics, and Google. He is currently the chairman and CEO of Sinovation, an AI-centric investment firm. Dr. Lee recently appeared on the television show, "60 Minutes," discussing his new book and the promise of AI in education.

A 1975 graduate of St. Mary Catholic School, Dr. Lee will speak to the students and teachers about AI technology and about China during the following assembly:
