




I hope your Thanksgiving Day celebration was as nice as mine was. I am thankful for being able to celebrate the day with my brother Brian and his wife Rita. Brian is wrestling with Dementia/Alzheimer's Disease. I know, in time, he may not be able to re



My brother's condition causes me to approach Advent differently this year. It is an opportunity for me to reflect upon my life and to recognize those moments when I have had "spiritual Alzhiemer's" – moments when I "forget" that God is with me.

The beauty of Advent and especially Christmas is that we embrace the truth: "that God never forgets us." As we prepare to celebrate Christmas, let us take time to reflect upon and meditate upon this truth. Let us never "forget" – Emmanuel, "God is with us."

This week we celebrate how God chose to come to us through the instrument of his grace – Mary. This Wednesday is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We will have three opportunities on Wednesday to celebrate this blessed event. Mass will be celebrated at the following times:

8:30 a.m. at St. Stephen's 12:15 p.m. at St. Joseph's 6:30 p.m. at St. Stephen's.

I hope you will join me at one of those times to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary.

During Advent I will be hearing confessions at St. Stephen's after weekday morning Masses. I will hear confessions at St. Joseph's on Wednesdays from 12:15-1:45 p.m. These times are in addition to the regular confession times of 6-7 p.m. on Wednesdays and 9-10 a.m. on Saturdays.

PLEASE NOTE: Because of the holy day Mass schedule on December 8th, I will not hear confessions at St. Joseph's that day, nor will there be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and confessions that evening.

The priests of Our Family of Parishes are scheduled to hear confessions at St. Mary's in Port Huron, on Friday the 17th, beginning at 6 p.m. Hopefully, the new variant of the corona virus will not prevent us from gathering that evening.

Have a blessed week, and I hope to see you at one of the holy day Masses on December 8th.

How very fitting that God uses HIS chosen servants, the priest, to be HIS conduit for this welcoming back!!




