I hope you will stop by today (Sunday, September 10th) at St. Joe's and celebrate the 100th anniversary of the building's presence and service in the community. Have a hot dog or a burger and visit with others and take



a burger and visit with others and take time to peruse the fine features of the church. The gathering will take place from noon to 2:30 p.m.

I will be away next week, from the 18th – 22nd, attending the Archdiocese of Detroit Priest Convocation at Boyne Mountain. It is an event scheduled every two years. It is an opportunity for us priests to come together for enrichment, fellowship, and prayer.

There will be no weekday Masses celebrated during my absence. Nor will there be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and confessions that Wednesday. Fr. Zbig, at St. Mary's, will be unable to attend the convocation, so you can attend weekday Masses there during that week. I plan to be back at the parish on the night of the 22nd.



"Upon This Rock I Will Build My Church."



Originally budgeted for \$85,000, the final cost was \$112,000 (\$1,966,939 in 2023). Also at the same time, a new convent was built on Chestnut for \$15,000, where the parking lot is today. The parish had to take out a \$50,000 (\$878,098 in 2023) mortgage. Close to 100 Pewabic tiles were used on the façade of the church, for a cost of \$45. It would take some years for the parish to save up money to really decorate the interior. At the time of the dedication, the only stained glass were the rose windows and the five windows in the sanctuary. The altar from the original church was brought across the street and was in use until 1946. This altar was built by the founding pastor, Fr. Clement Krebs, using shipping crates. After painting the interior of the church with goldleaf and a faux marble in 1939, the parish ordered an Italian marble alter in 1940. Unfortunately, due to the outbreak of WWII, the altar sat in Italy until it could be delivered in 1946. This marble altar with a relic of a pelican feeding its young served the parish until 1969, when the church was redecorated. Also brought over from the original church, were the statues of Mary and St. Joseph. Sometime in the early 1980's, the statue of St. Joseph fell, and broke. New fiberglass statues were purchased to replace the originals. The original statue of Mary is currently in the South transept. The three original bells from 1890 were placed in North belltower. The statue of St. Anthony, also found in the South transept, has been in the church since 1923. When St. Jospeh parish was founded in 1889, there was a large German population in that part of town; however, by the time the current church was built, there was a large number of Irish people living and attending St. Jospeh's. To honor these two cultures, the parish placed statues of St. Boniface and St. Patrick in the sanctuary. Unfortunately, these statues have been lost with the test of time.




