Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary *August 15*

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God.

Venerable Pope Pius XII confirmed this belief about the Virgin Mary when he defined it formally as a dogma of Catholic faith in 1950, "that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

"It was fitting," St. John of Damascus wrote in a sermon on the Assumption, "that she, who had kept her virginity intact in childbirth, should keep her own body free from all corruption even after death," and "that she, who had carried the Creator as a child at her breast, should dwell in the divine tabernacles."

The Feast of the Assumption is always a Holy Day of Obligation for both Roman and Eastern-rite Catholics, on which they are obliged to attend Mass or Divine Liturgy. Because the Feast Day this year falls on a Monday, the obligation is lifted. However, here at St. Charles Borromeo, there will be a 7:30 A.M. Mass on Monday, August 15th in Mauret Family Life Center.

"Come, Holy Spirit! Set my heart on fire."

Jesus' words about setting the earth on fire can be confusing—even frightening. It might remind us of a forest fire that consumes everything in its path. It's true that fire in Scripture often symbolizes the purifying presence and judgment of God. But fire also represents the Holy Spirit, particularly in the Gospel of Luke and the Book of Acts.

In Luke, John the Baptist prophesies that the Messiah will come to "baptize you with the holy Spirit and fire" (3:16). And Jesus does just that. Just before his ascension, he tells his disciples, "I am sending the promise of my Father upon you" and "You will be baptized with the holy Spirit" (Luke 24:49; Acts 1:5). He then fulfills that promise on Pentecost when the Spirit comes upon them like "tongues as of fire" (Acts 2:3).

Jesus longed with all his heart for the Holy Spirit to fill his disciples—and the whole earth! He couldn't wait to see the fire of the Spirit blazing forth and bringing light to every dark corner of the world. This was why he came; it was the goal of his entire mission. It's why he would endure the "baptism" of his passion and death (Luke 12:50).

Jesus' heart burns with love for us, and he wants his Spirit to fill us with that love. Like fire, the Spirit changes everything he touches. His fire will warm our hearts so they burn with love for him and the people around us. His fire will purify our hearts so we will want to live holy lives that please the Lord. And his fire will enflame our hearts with a passion to tell everyone about the love of Jesus.

Jesus wants that transforming power to blaze in each of us until it fills the whole earth.
