Lenten Reflection - Week 3

In today's gospel, we meet a Samaritan woman who encounters Jesus at the well. The woman, who many believed was of such low standing, was there to quench her thirst. Jesus' meeting with the woman was intentional, as He saw her need for salvation. She, like so many of us, was not just physically thirsting but spiritually parched. Unlike the water from the well, Jesus offers the woman the "water of eternal life." He tells her that those who drink of the water will never thirst again. Jesus also showed Himself as the "living water" to be shared by all, regardless of our circumstances.

In our daily lives, we often try to satisfy our needs with a mirage of possessions and desires. We, like the woman at the well, need to know that we are loved by God and that only He can satisfy our spiritual needs.

Are we willing to dive deeper into the well of salvation?


