Reflection - Week 5

Today's gospel tells the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead. This parable is significant because this was Jesus' last miracle before he began the journey towards his own death. Jesus used the miracle of raising Lazarus from the dead to strengthen the faith of all who believed, and so that all could witness God's glory.

In raising Lazarus, Jesus shows his power over death, so that when Jesus dies, those who believe in him will remember that, and have hope. After all, the central element of our Catholic faith is the promise of eternal life. *Do you believe?*

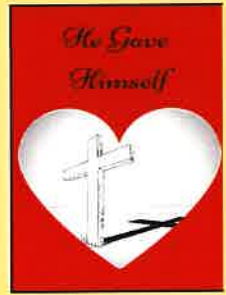
