## Lenten Reflection – Holy Week

As we begin Holy Week, we hear two contrasting gospels. In the first, Jesus triumphantly enters Jerusalem and is revered by a large crowd. In the second, we endure the painful story of Jesus' betrayal, arrest, and crucifixion. Throughout this Lenten season, we are reminded through the gospels that Jesus' death was neither accidental nor blind fate, but a destiny that he faced of his own accord. Throughout all of his trials, Jesus remained steadfast in his love and was willing to suffer, rather than betray his Father's mission.

To those who betrayed him, he offered compassion. For those who denied him, he humbly asked them to follow him. Facing torture, ridicule, and a death sentence, he stoically refused to argue for his life.

Palm Sunday serves as a reminder of the welcoming of Jesus into our hearts and of our willingness to follow him. Everything we need to know about our faith is found in the death of Jesus Christ on the cross and his resurrection in the coming days.
