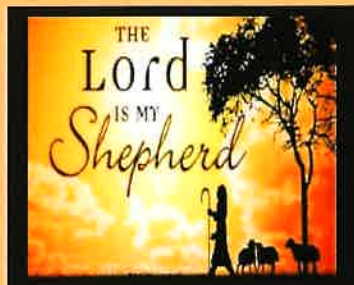
Family Day "Thank You!"
