Facilities Restoration Update

I am aware that people have been asking for an update on when the repairs to the church will begin. I have not given an update because we have been in limbo since the last update. Regarding the roof on the Mauret Family Life Center, Axe National Management Services, LLC, has completed most items, but they have one more to finish. They have ordered and are awaiting a storm collar for the pipe in which the electric cord goes into the roof for the kitchen exhaust hood to arrive for the final completion.

Regarding the Church: On May 25th we received bids to repair and reroof the Church/office complex. The company which had the lowest bid was not providing us with the documentation needed and was not certified with any of the companies to do the flat portion of the roof. Therefore, after consultation with our Diocesan Attorneys, they informed us that we could move to the next bidder. We recently contracted with Roofing Solutions, LLC. On Wednesday, September 27, 2023, we had a pre-construction conference with them. They have provided the documents needed, and they are in the process of applying for a permit from the Parish.

We also know that more areas in our church/office need to be remediated to remove additional mold and damaged materials. Upon receiving the test results and a detailed protocol from our Environmental consultant, Air Test Associates, LLC, we will proceed to get proposals from remediation contractors to complete the cleanup. This will allow us to continue work on the next phase of our project, the interior restoration of the Church.

If I don't have the answer at the time, I will get it and respond with the information. Thank you for your understanding and we continue to pray for patience.
