THE SEASON OF LENT IS APPROACHING!

All the faithful are encouraged to give thought and reflection as to how we want to spiritually enter into and to keep the holy season of Lent, which begins on **Ash Wednesday**, **February 14**TH.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

When Is Fasting Observed? Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

By Whom?: by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59.

What Constitutes Fasting?: Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals which do not equal a full meal are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Abstinence from Meat: is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years or older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent. The determination of certain days as obligatory days of penance should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance.

Fasting and Abstinence on Good Friday: While eating seafood, such as crawfish, satisfies the abstinence requirement on Good Friday, we also need to remember that it is a day of fasting, which means that we are obliged to limit the amount of food we take only to that which we need to sustain us for the day. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection. If people gather to eat we should keep in mind that Good Friday is a solemn day of prayer and penance in honor of the Lord who gave his life for our salvation.


