A friend once asked me,

"Why do you pray?" This question took me by surprise because it seemed simple to answer yet I never really thought about it. As Catholics, we hear how important prayer is all the time but for many people, prayer can be difficult. It is hard to pray when we forget, become too busy, or even see what purpose it serves in our lives. A harsh reality I have come to is that if you do not pray, you do not really know God. How can you claim to know someone you do not spend time with? Our relationship with God is reciprocal and He is always inviting us to respond to this relationship he freely offers us. It is by our pursuance of a personal prayer life that we are given the grace to follow God's plan and the ability to come to a deeper understanding of who God is and who we are.

Something to ponder: *What does my prayer life look like right now and how do I prioritize my relationship with God? Begin a habit of setting aside 15 minutes each day to pray*
