

## Palabras de Nuestro Vicario Parroquial

Queridos feligreses,

Hoy celebramos el segundo domingo de Adviento. La liturgia nos presenta a San Juan Bautista proclamando "Preparad el camino del Señor, enderezad sus caminos". (Lc.3:4) Él dice que Dios llenará cada valle, y aplanará cada colina. Debemos llenar de confianza en Dios los valles de nuestra desesperación, Debemos bajar las colinas de nuestro orgullo, para hacer un camino para nuestro Salvador, que viene en humildad y silencio. Continúa diciendo que "el Señor guiará a Israel en medio de la alegría y a la luz de su gloria, escoltándolo con su misericordia y su justicia." (Baruch 5,9). Nuestro Salvador enderezará sus caminos hacia Él, hacia nuestra salvación. Nosotros complicamos la vida, buscando a Dios donde no se encuentra. Pasamos por los caminos llenos de baches de nuestros hábitos poco saludables que no nos permiten estar en un camino recto hacia Dios. San Pablo, en la carta a los Filipenses, dice: "que el que comenzó una buena obra en Uds. continuará completándola hasta el día de Cristo Jesús". (Fil.1:6) Esta es una fuente de alegría. Dios quiere que su obra de arte, que es cada uno de nosotros, sea perfeccionada y terminada. Su gracia nunca nos faltará. Depende de nosotros colaborar con su gracia, y colaborar con el Espíritu Santo para que Él nos haga hombres y mujeres santos, otros Cristos. San Francisco de Sales lo interpreta de esta manera: "Cada momento del tiempo viene hacia ti con una tarea que completar, y también con la gracia de completarla bien; luego regresa a la eternidad para permanecer eternamente, tal como tú la has dejado". Pídele a Nuestro Señor que nos llene de gozo durante este tiempo de Adviento. Él hará todas las cosas bien. Él nos mostrará el camino hacia la paz y la prosperidad. Pidamos a la Santísima Virgen María que nos ayude a prepararnos para la Navidad, con esta alegría, y nuestro trabajo espiritual de sacrificio y oración. 12:30pm. Following by a Lunch Reception with Mariachis and Matachines. It will be held in the Chavez Center. Please join us for this celebration.





## From our Parochial Vicar

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the second Sunday of Advent. The liturgy presents to us St John the Baptist proclaiming "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." (Lk.3:4) He says God will fill every valley, and every hill made flat. We must fill the valleys of our despair, filling it with trust in God. We must lower the hills of our pride, to make a path for our Savior, who is coming in humility and silence. He goes on to say that He will straighten winding roads and make rough roads even. Our Savior will straighten our paths to Him, to our salvation. We tend to complicate life, looking for God where He is not found. We go through the bumpy roads of our unhealthy habits that don't permit us to be on a straight path to God.

St Paul in the letter to the Philippians, says: "that the one who began a good work in you will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus." (Phil.1:6) This is a source of joy. God wants His work of art which is each one of us to be perfected and finished. His grace will never be lacking to us. It is up to us to collaborate with His grace, and to collaborate with the Holy Spirit so that He may make of us holy men and women, other Christs. St. Francis de Sales interprets it this way: "Every single moment of time comes toward you with a task to complete, and also with the grace to complete it well; it then returns to eternity to remain eternally, just as you have left it."

In the first reading of Baruch, we read: "God is leading Israel in joy by the light of his glory, with his mercy and justice for company." (Bar.5:9) Ask Our Lord to fill us with joy during this Advent season. He will make all things right. He will show us the path to peace and prosperity. Let us ask the Blessed Virgin Mary to help us to prepare ourselves for Christmas, with this joy, and our spiritual work of sacrifice and prayer. She teaches us how to discover behind each person, each circumstance, and each difficulty - the most Holy Will of God. Fr. Dennis Venegas



#### SAINT OF THE DAY -

**St. Juan Diego**, canonized July 31, 2002; (feast day December 9); was visited by the Virgin Mary (Our Lady of Guadalupe). Juan Diego experienced his first vision of the Virgin Mary on December 9, 1531. While on his way to mass, he was visited by Mary, who was surrounded in heavenly light, on

Tepeyac Hill on the outskirts of what is now Mexico City. She spoke to him in his native language and asked him to tell the bishop to build a shrine to her on the hill. The bishop did not believe Juan Diego's story and asked for proof that Mary had appeared to him. On December 12, while searching for a priest to administer last rites to his uncle. Juan Diego was visited by Mary again. He told her of the bishop's answer, and she instructed him to gather roses and take them to the bishop as a sign. She also informed Juan Diego that his uncle would recover from his illness. Juan Diego found many roses on the hill even though it was winter. When he opened his tilma (cloak) while appearing before the bishop, dozens of roses fell out, and an image of Mary, imprinted on the inside of his cloak, became visible. Having received his proof, the bishop ordered that a church be built on Tepeyac Hill in honour of the Virgin. For the rest of his life Juan Diego lived in a hut next to the church built in honor of Mary. He was buried in the church, and his tilma can still be seen in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Juan Diego was beatified on May 6, 1990, and canonized on July 31, 2002, by Pope John Paul II.
