## 22<sup>ND</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today we see St. Peter in another light as he attempts to dissuade Jesus from taking the path of the cross. Jesus responds, “Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are not thinking as God does, but as human beings do” (MT 16:23). How many of us become an obstacle to the divine plan when we do things our way instead of God’s way? Prayer is an opportunity for us to reflect on God’s way before we start off on our daily path. That is why a morning offering prayer is so important to begin the day, lest we get on the road of life and lose our way without the grace of God’s inspiration. Indeed, Jesus reminds us that the way to heaven is by taking up our daily cross, the cross which leads to the resurrected life (cr. MT 16:24-27). St. Paul reminds us not to conform our lives to this present age but to be transformed by the renewal of our minds in Christ so that we can offer up our entire being as a living sacrifice to God (cr. Rom. 12:1-2). Let us pray to have the grace to take up the cross and to follow Jesus unto the glory of the risen life for all eternity with God in heaven.

## RCIA





WELCOME BACK TO MASS!

Please see the condensed Directives for Public Worship to help ensure our faith community remains safe and healthy. A full description of the **Mass Directives** can be found on the home page of the parish website at [www.annunciationparishabq.org](http://www.annunciationparishabq.org).

- 1) Everyone returning to mass is **REQUIRED** to wear a mask to enter by State Order. *The exception is for children under 3 years of age.*
- 2) Everyone entering is asked to maintain a 6 foot distance from people, other than their family members. Family members may sit together space provided. Ushers will be directing people to available seats.
- 3) The church doors will open 30 minutes prior to the scheduled Mass. All members entering must enter through the front doors and sanitize their hands.
- 4) Everyone is to exit through the designated exits on the left and right sides of the church.
- 5) Once we have reached capacity in the church, on a first come first served basis, the overflow will be directed to the gym where the Mass will be live streamed on the big screen.
- 6) Reception of Communion will take place at the end of the Mass. Those in the overflow will be directed by ushers accordingly.
- 7) Upon approaching the Blessed Sacrament, you may loosen your mask, for example, by one loop, then receive in the hand and make your Communion. Thereafter, don the mask and leave quietly without congregating but making your prayer of thanksgiving on your way home.
