From the Pastor

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's liturgy takes us into the mystery of the Beatitudes as recorded in the 6th Chapter of St. Luke. The Beatitudes are Jesus' summary of the Christian's ideals for this life and the inclination toward heavenly values for the next life. When one looks at poverty being a blessing, we should not think of abject poverty—which we do our best to alleviate—but rather a poverty of spirit which calls for dependence on God. The lesson being taught is that without God we are very poor, but with God we have all the riches and blessings of heaven. The prophet Jeremiah teaches this



well when he makes the following contrast in Jer. 17:5-8, Cursed is the one who trusts in human beings, who seeks his strength in flesh, whose heart turns away from the Lord. He is like a barren bush in the desert....Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose hope is the Lord. He is like a tree planted beside the waters that stretches out its roots to the stream...; in the year of drought it shows no distress, but still bears fruit. The Beatitudes call us to put our trust in the Lord even when we are persecuted for our faith. The psalmist reminds us in Psalm 1 that those who meditate on the law of the Lord will find their delight in the Lord. St. Paul reminds the Corinthians in 1 Cor. 15 that we find hope in the Lord because Jesus has indeed been raised from the dead. If we take the teachings and laws of the Risen Savior to heart, we will indeed find hope no matter what trials we face. Let us trust that Jesus can and will turn our trials and tribulations into blessings yet to be realized!
