The Parish Budget for Fiscal Year 2024 (7/1/24 - 6/30/25) is based on the giving of our faith family for Fiscal Year 2024. The portion of our budget contributed in envelopes, checks, loose cash and online giving is \$1,768,000.00 or \$34,000.00 per week.

Contributions for the 48th weekend of the fiscal year were \$22,962.00. In the 48th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$1,632,000.00, and our collections are \$1,745,926.00.

THE SOLEMNITY OF PENTECOST

Today, we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the early Church. After much prayer with Our Lady and the Apostles, the Church experienced what some refer to as the birthday of the Church. From this day forward, the formerly weak and timid Apostles became fearless preachers promulgating the Kingdom of God and the Gospel of Jesus Christ. By the power of the Holy Spirit, faith was enkindled again and again among new believers. Despite the great odds and difficulties, these founders of faith became courageous leaders. Have we submitted our hearts to the Holy Spirit? As we receive the Easter sacrament of Baptism and become receivers of the Holy Spirit, we also receive the Pentecost sacrament of Confirmation to become transmitters of the same Spirit. Be for me the living and life-giving Breath of God, the very air I breathe. Amen. Alleluia!
