The Parish Budget for Fiscal Year 2024 (7/1/24 - 6/30/25) is based on the giving of our faith family for Fiscal Year 2024. The portion of our budget contributed in envelopes, checks, loose cash and online giving is \$1,768,000.00 or \$34,000.00 per week.

Contributions for the 49th weekend of the fiscal year were \$53,504.00 (Which includes online giving for week 47 & 48). In the 49th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$1,666,000.00, and our collections are \$1,822,587.00.

# From the Pastor

## SOLEMNITY OF THE HOLY TRINITY

Today we celebrate Trinity Sunday, God's own feast day! God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit is an eternal community of three distinct Persons united in one Being, which St. John says is love (1 JN 4:8). In that sense, God has never been alone, even before creation. But God created the world out of love and then the human person in the divine image and likeness, with intellect and will. Do we ever thank the Father in heaven for the gift of life, the Son for our redemption and the Holy Spirit for our ongoing sanctification? This would be the perfect day to do so as St. Paul reminds us in Romans 5:5, "hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us." While all the sacraments are trinitarian, the Sacrament of Matrimony is perhaps the best to reflect that reality of three in one. As Archbishop Fulton Sheen was fond of saying, "there are really three to get married: man, woman and Christ." As in God, there is a unitive aspect in marriage where the two become one in Christ's love. In addition, there is the outflow of God's love in creation, just as man and woman pour out themselves in the procreation of children. Once we see a renewed respect for both the unitive and procreative aspects of marriage, the sacrificial love of God will surely be reflected in Christian matrimony. Let us pray for the renewal of marriage and family life to reflect the beauty of divine love in all of our Catholic homes and thereby contribute to the renewal of the family and of marriage in our nation and our world. Blessed be the Most Holy Trinity and the love of God forever!




## FATHERS DAY


