Contributions for the 50th weekend of the fiscal year were \$32,416.00. In the 50th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$1,700,000.00, and our collections are \$1,854,978.00.



## SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Today the Church celebrates Corpus Christi, the gift of the Holy Eucharist throughout the world. What a gift God has for us in the Eucharist, truly the Body and Blood of the Savior, Jesus Christ.
