# From the Pastor

## 14TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In today's gospel, LK 10:1-20, Jesus reminds us, in verse 9, that: the Kingdom of God is at hand. There is an urgency in Jesus' call to proclaim this good news in the midst of an evil generation. It seems that we are in the same situation today, almost two thousand years later! Are we ready to heed the call as laborers for the gospel? Yes, this is a direct call for priests, deacons and religious, but it is also a call for all Christians to propagate the message of Jesus and bring hope to the world. I cannot help but think of our



dear seminarian, Jason Marshall, whose memorial we celebrated here recently after his untimely death in the bus accident coming back from Denver with our young adults on Sunday, June 23rd, 2019. Many of you know that Jason's vocation was a second vocation after his career as an inspector with the health department in New York City. Once he realized the Lord's call, Jason gave his all in pursuing the priestly life. While he was but a few years away from Ordination to the Priesthood, Jason sacrificed his life by taking the wheel of the bus which was out of control. Jason died so that others might live and in fact all the others on board were saved, except for the bus driver Anthony Padilla. Perhaps we are not called to such a dramatic service, but we are all called to offer our lives back to God who gives us life in order that we might bring many others to the Lord. When we follow this path of evangelizing the world with the good news of grace and mercy in Christ, we will indeed be consoled despite the trials and tribulations involved. The Lord speaks through the prophet Isaiah 65:17 saying ...I am about to create new heavens and a new earth; the former things shall not be remembered or come to mind. Then in today's first reading the Lord says, in Isaiah 66:13, ...as a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you.... These words give us hope in the divine plan which ends in victory which is why St. Paul can say, in Gal 6:14, May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ.... We know that the cross is not the end of the road because there is the third day triumph of the resurrection. May the Risen Savior triumph in our lives and our world!

## CATHOLIC ETIQUETTE

 As the warm weather is upon us in full force, it is time to remember that God's house is a place of worship and not a beach club. When you come into the sanctuary of the church, prepare yourself with modest dress and silent wonder as you present yourself to Jesus Christ the Lord. In addition, if your little ones are agitated, do not hesitate to take them to the vestibule or to the cry room until they can calm down and return to the sanctuary. Please do not allow your children to go to the restroom alone but accompany them so that no harm should come to them. Let us also show respect for God and neighbor by giving people the quiet they need to prepare themselves for the sacred mysteries. Visiting one's neighbor can take place in the vestibule and in the plaza after Mass while reserving the sanctuary as a place to pray and converse with God. Let us never distract others from the true reason we gather in church—to worship and praise the Living God!
