From the Pastor

15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's gospel gives us the great Parable of the Good Samaritan. What leads Jesus into telling this parable is an encounter with a scholar of the law who stood up to test Jesus by asking in Luke 10:25: Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life? Jesus responds by posing the question to the scholar, who answers correctly with loving God and neighbor. Then Jesus uses the Parable of the Good Samaritan in order to illuminate just whom that neighbor includes. You see, Samaritans were considered former members of the faith of Israel who apostatized from the true worship of God at the Temple in Jerusalem. Therefore, to have a Samaritan be the one who does the work of mercy to the man struck down on the road to Jerusalem would have been abhorrent to many Jews. Jesus' point is that everyone is my neighbor in God's eyes, even the one whose culture, language or religion may be alien to me. In his Letter to the Colossians, St. Paul teaches us the Jesus created all things and holds us all together in unity as the head of the body, the Church. Thus, we must build up unity among all peoples, even those with whom we disagree. It takes the Word of God to find our common ground and as Moses says in Deut. 30:14-16 ...It is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts: you have only to carry it out. Here, then, I have today set before you life and prosperity, death and doom. If you obey the commandments of the Lord, your God, which I enjoin on you today, loving him, and walking in his ways, and keeping his commandments, statutes and decrees, you will live and grow numerous, and the Lord, your God, will bless you.... The Catechism of the Catholic Church, #1888-1889, reminds us that we must be in a permanent state of inner conversion in order to live for the common good of God's social order: Without the help of grace, men would not know how to discern the often narrow path between the cowardice which gives in to evil, and the violence which under the illusion of fighting evil only makes it worse. This is the path of charity, that is, of the love of God and of neighbor. Charity is the greatest social commandment. It respects others and their rights. It requires the practice of justice, and it alone makes us capable of it. Charity inspires a life of self-giving.... Let us pray that we will all have the courage and charity to act like the Good Samaritan to the many wounded souls we encounter day by day.
