# From the Pastor

## TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

After Jesus' challenging teaching on the need to forgive even seven times a day, if necessary, in the 17th Chapter of Luke, the apostles say to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" in verse 5. Jesus then uses the image of the mustard seed, a very tiny seed, as an analogy of faith powerful enough to do mighty things. That is the kind of faith of which St. Paul speaks to St. Timothy in 2 Tm. 1:6-7 when he says: "I remind you to stir into flame the gift of God that you have...of power and love and self-control." Perhaps you have practiced your faith and prayed faithfully for years and wondered, like the Prophet Habakkuk, when your faith would be fulfilled and your prayers answered. Do not give up hope, for as the Lord told Habakkuk in Hb. 2:3-4: "For the vision still has its time, presses on to fulfillment, and will not disappoint; if it delays, wait for it, it will surely come, it will not be late. The rash one has no integrity; but the just one, because of his faith, shall live." Now is not the time to give up on prayer as the world needs our prayer and our witness of mercy more than ever. Beseech the Lord to increase your faith and then exercise it with confidence and trust! Oh Lord, increase our faith and help us trust You!



## RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY



Today we join Catholics nationwide in celebrating Respect Life Sunday with the theme of "Life: Our Sign of Hope." Jesus makes it clear in Matt. 25:40 that when we show mercy to the least among us, we show it to him. Who are the least among us today? Let us begin with the innocent children in the womb—completely defenseless and dependent upon others to protect and nurture their lives. What about the sick and the elderly who are sometimes neglected and subjected to assisted suicide? What about the victims of domestic violence, war and human trafficking right here in Albuquerque? Sadly, the list goes on and on with so many cruelties in our day. Now is the time for us to stand up for what St. Paul calls, in Phil. 4:8, "whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure...."
