The Parish Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 (7/1/25 - 6/30/26) is based on the giving of our faith family for Fiscal Year 2025. The portion of our budget contributed in envelopes, checks, loose cash and online giving is \$1,891,760.00 or \$36,380.00 per week.

Contributions for the 16th weekend of the fiscal year were \$28,195.00. In the 16th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$582,080.00, and our collections are \$538,934.00.


From the Pastor

THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today our liturgy focuses on the race we run in this life to our heavenly home. Toward the end of his life, St. Paul wrote to St. Timothy in 2 Tm. 4 that he had competed well, finished the race and kept the faith. Each of us must do so, for as the Book of Sirach 35:12-17 points out: The Lord is a God of justice, who knows no favorites. Though not unduly partial toward the weak, yet He hears the cry of the oppressed.... The one who serves God willingly is heard; his petition reaches the heavens. The prayer of the lowly pierces the clouds; it does not rest till it reaches its goal.... Like the tax collector in LK 18:9-14, we may have to simply pray O God, be merciful to me a sinner. With such a contrite heart, the Lord will lift us up, as v. 14 states: ...whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted. Let us rise up with humility, a foundational virtue for a good relationship with God, and get back into the race to heaven through prayer and service of God and neighbor.



ALL SAINTS DAY AND ALL SOULS DAY



We will celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints Day on Saturday, Nov. 1st. Though it is not a holy day of obligation this year, the feast day will begin with a vigil on Friday, Oct. 31st, All Hallows Eve, at the 5:30 p.m. Mass. On Nov. 1, All Saints Day, we will have an 8:30 a.m. and a 10:30 a.m. Mass. Please join us as we call to mind our true vocation from baptism, the call to holiness for every one of us, modeled for us by those who have been canonized and declared saints by the Church. We also celebrate those holy souls whom we have known who have been witnesses to the love of God and neighbor but have yet to be officially canonized. We will begin the Commemoration of all the Faithful
