The Parish Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 (7/1/25 - 6/30/26) is based on the giving of our faith family for Fiscal Year 2025. The portion of our budget contributed in envelopes, checks, loose cash and online giving is \$1,891,760.00 or \$36,380.00 per week.

Contributions for the 18th weekend of the fiscal year were \$23,528.00. In the 18th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$605,077.00, and our collections are \$654,840.00. Our collections for All Saints was: \$2,671.00.



# From the Pastor

## THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

Today the Church celebrates the anniversary of the dedication of St. John Lateran's Basilica, the Cathedral of Rome. It was in fact erected by the first Emperor to convert to Christianity, Constantine, son of St. Helena. St. John's is the Cathedral of Rome, where the popes resided for over a thousand years, before moving to St. Peter's Basilica. St. John's Basilica is still Rome's Cathedral and where the Holy Father, as Bishop of Rome, offers Mass on Holy Thursday and other holy days particular to the Diocese and the people of Rome. It is considered the mother church of Christendom, as the first cathedral built after the Church was freed and was permitted to come out of the catacombs.



The Scriptures, today, speak to us of the Church as the "Father's house", cf. JN 2:16, and reminds us that by virtue of our baptism, we too are God's house. St. Paul asks the question, "Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for the temple of God, which you are, is holy" 1 Cor. 3: 16-17. St. Paul further reminds us that we must build the temple upon the true foundation which is Jesus Christ, cf. 1 Cor. 3:11. Perhaps we should ask ourselves if we are really building our spiritual lives upon Jesus, lives rooted in a personal relationship of love for the Lord. Are we developing virtues modeled by the saints and strengthened by the Holy Spirit in order to be temples pleasing to God? Are we falling for the trap of the worldly values of self-indulgence rather than cooperating with God's grace in a spiritual fitness program of self-mastery instead? Let us pray for the fortitude to persevere in running the long marathon race to eternal life by eschewing the deceits of this world and developing the graces given to us by Christ and the Church in the sacraments through lives of justice, charity and peace. Then, the light of these many Christian temples will draw others into the Kingdom of God, both now and forever.
