Contributions for the 28th weekend of the fiscal year were \$57,744.00. In the 28th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$1,018,640.00, and our collections are \$1,114,184.00.

Join our Scripture Study Group every Thursday morning at 9:30am (after morning mass) in St. Bakhita Hall as we explore the readings


for the coming Sunday. Gain a deeper understanding of God's word as a means of enriching your spiritual life. Spend an hour in fellowship and prayer.



From the Pastor

ECUMENICAL SUNDAY AND ORDINARY TIME

Having just celebrated the Feast of Our Lord's Baptism last week and we enter into Ordinary Time with the celebration of Ecumenical Sunday. We must seek to find the extraordinary graces God has for us even when things seem to have returned to the ordinary. Christian Unity is something Jesus prayed for before his death as recorded in JN 17:21, that they may all be one. We have been so blessed to be called together as the Church to receive the light of this grace and to become beacons of this light as the Lord said through the Prophet Isaiah in Is. 49:6, It is too little, the Lord says, for you to be my servant, to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and restore the survivors of Israel; I will make you a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth. As we learn from St. Paul in 1 Cor 1:3, we have been given grace and peace from God our Father in order that we might proclaim the victory of the cross of Jesus Christ. This is a commission that we share with all our fellow Christians and our disunity is a scandal that thwarts our witness to unbelievers. Are we willing to reach out to members of other denominations, our fellow Christians, and to build bridges of hope and light for the world to believe? In today's gospel, JN 1:29-34, we learn that Jesus came to baptize us with the Holy Spirit and we might ask ourselves how we are cooperating with the Holy Spirit in union with our fellow Christians in casting the divine fire of love into the hearts and souls of our community today. Come Lord Jesus and send your Holy Spirit to unite us in true Christian fellowship and love!
