The Parish Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 (7/1/25 - 6/30/26) is based on the giving of our faith family for Fiscal Year 2025. The portion of our budget contributed in envelopes, checks, loose cash and online giving is \$1,891,760.00 or \$36,380.00 per week.

Contributions for the 30th weekend of the fiscal year were \$36,887.00.00. In the 30th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$1,091,400.00, and our collections are \$1,184,208.00.


From the Pastor

FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's liturgy takes us into the Beatitudes proclaimed by Jesus at the beginning of his Sermon on the Mount, MT 5:1-12. This message is one which reverses what would often be considered a curse into a blessing. In order to see the blessing in these Beatitudes, one must approach them with humility—a prerequisite for the people of God. In Zep. 2:3, the Prophet Zephaniah tells us to: "Seek the Lord, all you humble of the earth, who have observed his law; seek justice, seek humility..." If there is to be any boasting, St. Paul, in 1 Cor. 1:31, says "Whoever boasts, should boast in the Lord." The Catechism of the Catholic Church, CCC 1717, says that the Beatitudes "...shed light on the actions and attitudes characteristic of the Christian life; they are the paradoxical promises that sustain hope in the midst of tribulations; they proclaim the blessings and rewards already secured, however dimly, for Christ's disciples...."




ANNUAL CATHOLIC KICK OFF



This year's theme for the ACA is "Fearless in Faith, Boundless in Love." Your contribution to the Annual Catholic Appeal Foundation directly impacts ministry to some of the most marginalized people in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe: those living with disabilities, at risk youth, the elderly, the sick, immigrants, those struggling with addictions, the incarcerated and many more. This year's goal is \$125,000 and added to our parish goal of another \$125,000 we come to a grand total of \$250,000. The rebate portion, which I remind you is untaxed by the Archdiocese, will go a long way in helping us continue safety projects around the school and church. If every family would participate with some donation, we could make a huge difference in providing for the education of our future priests and so many other important archdiocesan works. We begin our in pew solicitation for the ACA this weekend. If you have already received the ACA solicitation in the mail, you may bring your pledge to church or mail it in directly. Please consider joining in with your fellow parishioners this year in being a blessing to those in need right here in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe.


