The Parish Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 (7/1/25 - 6/30/26) is based on the giving of our faith family for Fiscal Year 2025. The portion of our budget contributed in envelopes, checks, loose cash and online giving is \$1,891,760.00 or \$36,380.00 per week.

Contributions for the 38th weekend of the fiscal year were \$29,097.00. In the 38th week of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$1,382,440.00, and our collections are \$1,478,454.00.

From the Pastor

PALM SUNDAY AND HOLY WEEK

This is the week in which we contemplate the suffering servant, the Lamb of God who is slain for love of us. As we enter spiritually into the passion, death and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ during this Holy Week, I invite you to join us in particular for the Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter. The Adoration Chapel will be closed from 7:00 p.m. Holy Thursday, when we begin the Mass of the Last Supper, until Easter Sunday. The 7:00 p.m. Holy Thursday Mass will be followed by the procession in



church to the day chapel, where adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place until midnight as we accompany Jesus at prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane. The Good Friday services are scheduled for 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Remember that Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence. The Easter Vigil, the most glorious liturgy of the year, begins Holy Saturday night at 7:00 p.m., when we light the Easter fire and welcome the Risen Lord into the church, along with our new Catholics, being baptized, confirmed and receiving their first holy communion. We will have the regular Sunday schedule on Easter morning: 7:00, 9:00 & 10:30 a.m. and 12 noon. Come rejoice in the Risen Lord and bring a friend to sing Alleluias with us to the Lord!

GOOD FRIDAY HOLY LAND COLLECTION



Christians around the world are united in a special way during Lent, Holy Week and Easter. Our hearts, minds and prayers are also especially aware of the Church in the Holy Land. Our parish, once a year on Good Friday, is called to support Christians in the Holy Land, many of whom depend on this collection for their very livelihood. As a pontifical collection, the Good Friday Collection offers a direct link for parishioners to be witnesses of peace and to help protect the holy sites. DIVINE MERCY NOVENA



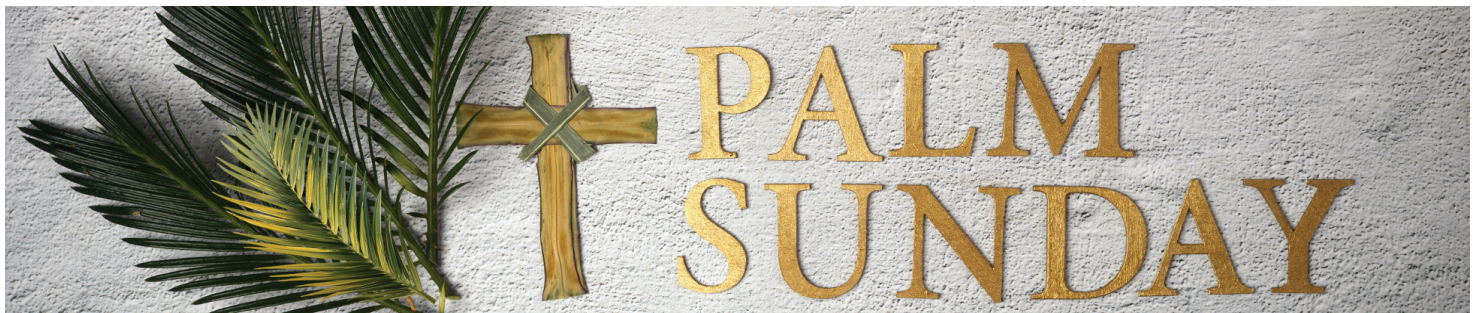
