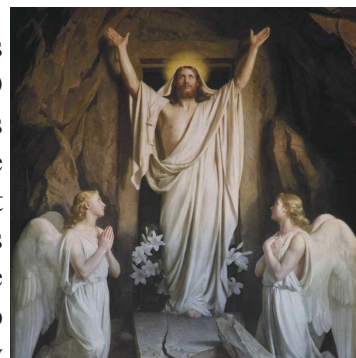

From the Pastor

EASTER SUNDAY

Rejoice heavenly powers! Sing choirs of angels! Exult all creation around God's throne! Jesus Christ, our King, is risen! Sound the trumpet of salvation! Rejoice O earth, in shining splendor, radiant in the brightness of your King! Christ has conquered! Glory fills you! Darkness vanishes forever! These words from the opening of the Exultet sung at the Easter Vigil each year are part of one of the most glorious hymns in the Church. Yes, the Church rejoices exultantly for Christ is risen as He said. Easter is the greatest Christian celebration of the year as we give thanks to God for the victory of Jesus over sin and death itself. We can truly lift up our hearts because the gates of heaven have opened wide and we have found a way out of the grave. No matter how difficult our times may be, we have hope because of the victory Jesus won for the believer. While there may be forty days of Lent, there are fifty days of Easter in which we can sing alleluias with abandon. Like the early Christians, let us be witnesses to those who are troubled in our own day with the grace and hope of Jesus' resurrection which triumphs over death and the power of sin in our personal lives. St. Paul reminds us in Col. 3:2 to "let your thoughts be on heavenly things, not on the things that are on earth." May you and yours experience the joy of the Risen Lord throughout this blessed season of Easter and bring that joy to many others as you proclaim: "Alleluia, Christ is risen as He said, alleluia, alleluia!"



THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY

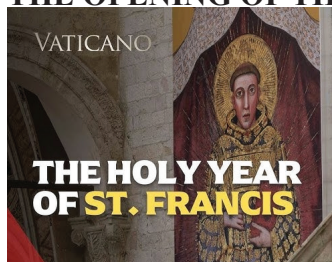

May this year inspire us to live the Gospel with joy, to bring hope to the poor, and to witness your love in every corner of our Archdiocese. We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen.
