The Parish Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 (7/1/25 - 6/30/26) is based on the giving of our faith family for Fiscal Year 2025. The portion of our budget contributed in envelopes, checks, loose cash and online giving is \$1,891,760.00 or \$36,380.00 per week.

Contributions for the 42nd weekend of the fiscal year were \$38,247.00. In the 42ndweek of our fiscal year, our budgeted goal for ministry programs and ordinary operating expenses were \$1,527,960.00, and our collections are \$1,653,019.00.

From the Pastor

GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

Today, the Fourth Sunday of Easter, is known as Good Shepherd Sunday. As we look at the 10th Chapter of John's Gospel, we hear Jesus say, "I came that they might have life and have it more abundantly." John 10:10 reminds us that no matter what it is that we are facing in life, whatever the challenges may be, Jesus, who is our Life, has come to give us the abundant life. That life comes to us through the grace He won for us on the cross and through the resurrection from the dead. That Easter grace is applied to each of us through baptism. Do we take our baptismal vows seriously? Are we living out this grace as intentional Catholics or are we just routine, automatic Catholics? In order to develop vocations in the family we need to take our baptismal call to heart as true disciples of the Lord, the priesthood of the laity. Then in a family which prays together and lives out Christian charity, the seeds of other vocations will be planted. So let us pray for and encourage good sacramental marriages which include loving one's spouse and children as the closest neighbor that anyone has. If we want good leaders in the Church, we need good examples of generous and joyful Catholics in our homes and in our community.
