CONSEQUENCES

- Level One:** To include but not limited to...
Silent lunch and recess on the day following the infraction
- Level Two:** To include but not limited to...
One hour before or after school detention
Exclusion from class parties, activities/sporting events, and field trips for five days
Sixth-Eighth grade students will be ineligible for Honor Roll that quarter in which the infraction is committed.
- Level Three:** To include but not limited to...
Meeting with parent(s), student, and administrative team
One day in-school suspension
Exclusion from class parties, activities/sporting events, and field trips for two weeks
Sixth-Eighth grade students will be ineligible for Honor Roll that quarter in which the infraction is committed.
- Level Four:** To include but not limited to...
Immediate out of school suspension of student pending a meeting of administrative team, student and parent(s) to determine course of action
Sixth-Eighth grade students will be ineligible for Honor Roll that quarter in which the infraction is committed.
For substance abuse and weapons policy violations, action will be taken in accordance with diocesan guidelines
- NOTE:** **Repeated violations at any level will be referred to the administrative team for consideration. Leadership from SRCES may be consulted as deemed necessary.**
