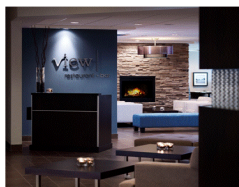

Thirteenth Week of Ordinary Time

On the **Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time** we hear the wonderful story of the healing of Jairus' daughter. In the middle of that story is the beautiful story of the healing of the woman with a hemorrhage. He said to her, 'Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction.'" Jesus tells Jairus, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." When the girl was healed the people "were utterly astounded."

Monday is the **Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul**, with its own special readings. Friday is the **Feast of Saint Thomas, Apostle**.

Matthew's Gospel follows Jesus on his journeys, constantly teaching his disciples about faithfulness. He challenges his disciples on what it means to follow him. He calms a violent storm at sea and heals two men possessed by demons -- demons who recognize Jesus as the "Son of God." When he is criticized for telling a paralytic his sins were forgiven, Jesus says, "Which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise and walk'? He then healed the paralytic. On Friday, Jesus does something extraordinary - he invites the reviled tax collector, Matthew, to be one of his followers. Then he indicates that the old ways of relating to God are gone - that he is the new way, the new wineskin.

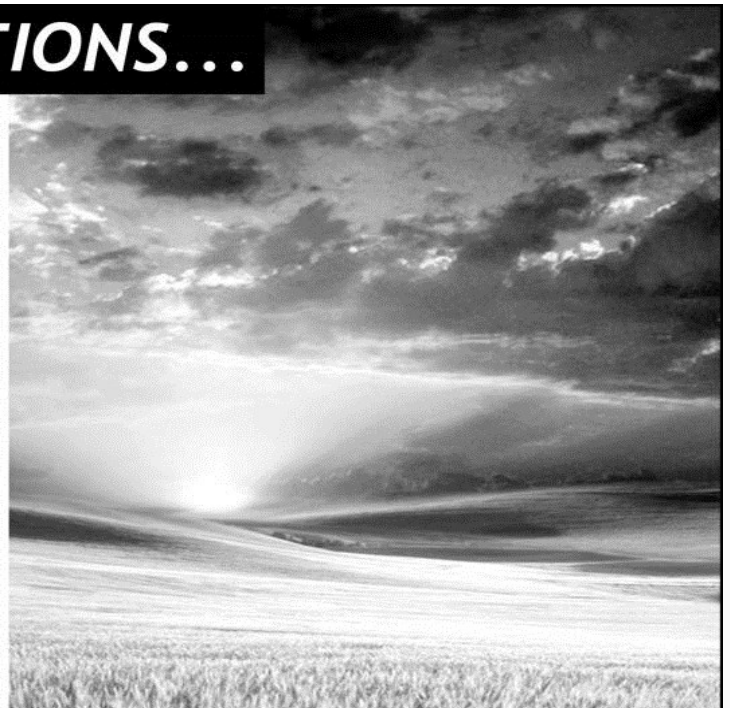
On the **Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time** we read that Jesus was not able to work miracles in his home town. In their eyes, he was just the person they'd seen grow up. This distressed him and he couldn't work many miracles at home.
