



Eighteenth Week of Ordinary Time

On the **18th Sunday in Ordinary Time**, we are in the second of five Sunday gospels from the 6th chapter of **John's gospel** and the Bread of Life readings. Jesus tells the crowd, "Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you."

Tuesday is the **Memorial of Saint John Vianney**, **Priest**. Thursday is the **Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord**, with its own special readings. Saturday is the **Memorial of Saint Dominic**, **Priest**.

We continue the story of Moses leading the Israelites out of Egypt. This week our readings are from the **Book of Numbers** for the first several days and from the **Book of Deuteronomy** on Friday.

In **Matthew's Gospel** this week we hear some marvelous words about faith and discipleship. The "feeding of the 5,000" comes after the disciples ask Jesus to send the crowd away because they didn't know how to feel them. Jesus tells them to "give them some food yourselves" and blesses the loaves and fishes. Jesus comes to his disciples across the water in a storm, and invites Peter to come to him, across the water; when Peter comes, he takes his eyes off Jesus and goes down. A persistent Cannanite woman begs Jesus for help for her daughter. When he refuses, she persists and he replies, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." Jesus asks his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" and Peter replies, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." But when Peter tries to stop Jesus from talking about the hardships that are ahead, Jesus tells him, "Get behind me, Satan!" He gives his followers a guide for their lives: "Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." The disciples wonder why they could not drive out a demon from a boy, Jesus answers, "Because of your little faith." Faith "the size of a mustard seed" is enough.

For this **Nineteenth Sunday of Ordinary Tim**e we finish our third Sunday with the Bread of Life readings from the 6th chapter of John's Gospel, meditating on the words of Jesus who reveals that he is the bread of life. Some of his hearers grumble about these shocking words. Jesus says, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."
