



Students currently in grade 8 (incoming freshmen): please complete, on your own, the <u>Incoming Student Scholarship</u> <u>Application</u> and submit no later than April 15, 2024.

Parents: please complete the <u>FACTS assessment form</u>, as nearly all of the scholarships are based on financial need as well. This will need to be completed to submit an application.
