

#### Fr. Mike Feast of the **Exaltation of the Cross**

On a certain Good Friday afternoon, following the Solemn Liturgy of the day, as I stood at the side door of St. Joseph church, two children came up with a drawing in their hands, a little child's representation of the crucified Lord. "Who made this?" I asked. "We did; we both did," was their reply. And they give it to me. They had made it, one would almost have to say, as their meditation on the mysteries we were celebrating

I was moved by its simplicity, its directness, with the great care with which it was executed (there are no erasures, no cross-outs or do-overs) and the sweet and unself


-conscious way in which they presented it to me.

The design is, to me, interesting. The cross itself, is like the cross we customarily see(†) in having a shorter horizontal and longer vertical member. But in this design, the cross beam intersects the vertical at about its mid-point (+). I suppose that's where the artists started. Then I *guess*, perhaps confined by the design of the cross they

I am probably way overanalyzing this little piece of devotional art. And I don't mean to say I think these children intended in any reflective way what I see. But I'd like to share with you what I do see from where I stand.

I see Jesus at rest, not (or not only) in death. I hear his words, "Father, into your hands, I commend my spirit." I interpret the hand that is nailed to the cross as a witness to the obedience of the Servant; and the other hand, though free of the cross, still in its place, as a witness to the freedom of the children of God. "No one takes [my life] from me, but I lay it down of my own free will. I have power to lay it down, and power to take it up again." (John 10:18) And the placement of the corpus high on the cross as it is, suggests to me Jesus *rising* even as he is dying on the cross. So this little drawing seems to me an especially good image of the "Mystery" of Jesus' death and resurrection, in which the dying is not tragic, but gracious, and the rising, has real meaning for today.

Christ suffered for you, and gave you an example, to have you follow in his footsteps.

He did no wrong; no deceit was found in his mouth. When he

was insulted, he réturned no insult. When he was offended, he did not counter with treats; instead he delivered himself up to the one who judges justly.

In his own body, be bore our sins to the cross, that we might live in accord with God's will.


