



Dear beloved Parishioners,

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus tells the story of the rich man and Lazarus—a parable that cuts to the heart of justice, compassion, and responsibility.

The rich man lives in luxury while Lazarus, a poor beggar, suffers at his gate. Their roles are reversed in the afterlife: Lazarus is comforted, and the rich man is tormented.

This parable challenges us to open our eyes to the suffering around us. It is not enough to avoid doing harm; we are called to actively do good. The sin of the rich man was not what he did, but what he failed to do—ignoring the need right at his doorstep.

Who is the "Lazarus" in your life today? Are you attentive to the needs of others, or are you too comfortable to notice? As disciples, we are invited to bridge the gap between comfort and compassion, between abundance and need. Let us pray for the Grace to see, to care, and to act.

2025 MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE PLAN (MCP)

The Missionary Cooperative Plan (MCP) in the United States is a nationwide initiative coordinated by Catholic dioceses to foster global missionary awareness and support. The MCP invites missionaries—priests, religious sisters and brothers, and lay missioners—from around the world to speak at Catholic parishes across the U.S. during the summer months. These visits aim to:

- Share stories of evangelization and service in under served regions
- Raise awareness of global Catholic missions
- Encourage prayer and financial support from parishioners

You may remember that last year we hosted a Franciscan Priest who did mission appeals for his congregation. This year (On the 27th Sunday Ordinary Time: October 4/5), Msgr. 


