## A MESSAGE FROM JAKE!

Parishioners of Holy Family,

Greetings from Scotland!



As you may remember from when I spoke at the parish this past summer, I have spent the past six months working with an organization called NET Ministries (National Evangelization Teams) here in Glasgow. For those who don't know me, I grew up in Novi, attending mass at Holy Family for my whole childhood, and graduated from Michigan State in the Spring of 2018. After graduating college, I served with NET in America for a year before being invited to supervise the team over here in Scotland.

The mission of NET is to challenge young people to love Christ and embrace the life of the Church. We do this by going into middle and high schools across six different countries and put on day-long retreats for the students nearly every weekday. The individual aspects of the retreats vary from day to day, but the goal is always to show Christ's love to the youth and present them with the life-changing message of the Gospel. As a supervisor, my job is to pastorally and logistically care for the missionary team here in Scotland.

Since we arrived here in Scotland in September, we have witnessed first-hand the power of the Holy Spirit working in the lives of the students we meet. The culture here is very secular and at times hostile to religion, which can be challenging, but it also opens up the door for God to work powerfully. We often witness students who start the day with us as atheists, and finish the day as Christians, and even express a desire to start a prayer life. Time and time again, we have been blown away by how quickly God can transform the hearts of these youth.

I've also loved getting to care for the missionary team here. Spending a year serving the Lord in such a radical way has helped them to grow so much spiritually, as it helped me last year. It has been such a privilege to walk alongside them on the journey of their faith lives and help push them to grow in to the men and women God created them to be.

When I spoke at Holy Family last summer, many of you faithfully donated to my cause, and I cannot express my gratitude to you enough. None of this would be possible without the generous contributions that I received from you. While I have now met my financial goal for the year, I am still asking for your support through prayer. Please pray for me, and know that I am regularly praying for the people of Holy Family Parish.

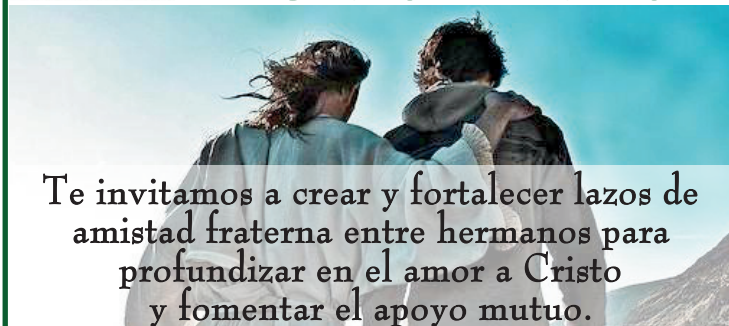

### The Presentation of the Lord

“... they took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord...” (Luke 2:22)

How seriously do you take being a Catholic? Is “being Catholic” something I just do when I attend Sunday Mass or attend one of my parish functions? It’s easy to be Catholic then, it’s harder to be Catholic when I am out in the world. Would someone recognize you as a Catholic by the way you act, dress, and talk? How do you present yourself to the Lord and to others?

### Stewards of the Church

The Scripture readings today speak of God’s promise to send a Savior to mankind. The prophet Malachi compares God’s messenger to refined precious metals. In the Letter to the Hebrews, the author explains how Jesus came to help not angels, but the descendants of Abraham. In the long form of St. Luke’s Gospel, the evangelist tells the story of Mary and Joseph taking the baby Jesus to the Temple. In accordance with the law, He is consecrated to the Lord. Simeon, a holy man, and Anna, a prophetess, are in the presence of the infant Jesus and witness the fulfillment of the ancient prophecies. As Paschal stewards, we strive to build a personal relationship with Christ and, in turn, be docile to His will. May this feast day move us, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to embrace Christ and, in a spirit of evangelization, do His work in our acts of stewardship with our parish communion. The second quarter of our fiscal year (2019-2020) has just ended. Our offertory is running very close to the increased budget amount for this year. Again, we thank you for your commitment and generosity. We are under budget in a number of areas of expense due to careful cost management though some is due to timing, primarily in Christian Service. The large cost overrun is due to several things that have occurred that were unplanned. Repairs and restriping of the parking lot was supposed to happen in May but the rains delayed that effort. A power issue in July required repairs to several cooling and pumping systems controls and our air conditioning repairs this quarter were far beyond expectations. These issues cost over \$50,000 in unplanned expenditures. The completion of the Donor Wall is in process and it has been ordered. The preliminary architectural work related to the updating of restrooms has been completed. You will see and hear more about these in the near future.
