Fr. Louis' Message

XXXIII of Ordinary Time

We reach the end of the liturgical year culminating in the feast of Christ the King. We have an opportunity to acknowledge honour and accept Christ Jesus our Lord as our King and the king of our lives individually. A challenge before us is not so much whether to accept Christ as our King or not for we have already received Him as our king but to see Him in everyone around us especially the poor. The Scripture readings present Jesus in his second coming as a true Shepherd reminding us of Christ's claim that he is the true shepherd and according to St. Paul Christ as the all-powerful ruler who raises the dead and to whom every other power and authority must eventually give way. Today's Gospel presents Christ the King coming in Heavenly glory to judge us, based on how we have shared our love and blessings with others through genuine acts of charity in our lives. We are invited to honor Christ as the King of the Universe by enthroning him in our hearts and allowing him to take control of our lives. When we accept Jesus as the King of our lives, then everything else falls into its proper place. As those belonging to Christ the King, we are invited to see that the effects of accepting Christ as the King reaches others so that we treat everyone with justice, equality, compassion and peace, especially the poor, unfortunate, homeless and victims of injustice. May Christ the king live in our hearts and our daily life.

The Happenings

Liturgical Guidelines during the Coronavirus Pandemic October 14, 2020

Given the continuing limitation on large public gatherings, and so as to allow people who are not well or otherwise at risk the ability to stay home, the following provisions will remain in effect until further notice:

- The general dispensation from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass remains in place.
- People in vulnerable populations are encouraged to stay home. High-risk individuals (e.g., people who are 65 and older, who are immuno-compromised or who have underlying health conditions) should be discouraged from serving in any capacity that brings them into contact with others.
- Live-streaming of Mass remains available.
- No social sharing of food or drink before or after Mass or any other gathering.



Pautas litúrgicas durante la pandemia de coronavirus 14 de octubre de 2020

Dada la limitación continua sobre las grandes reuniones públicas, y para permitir que las personas que no se encuentren bien o que estén en riesgo puedan quedarse en casa, las siguientes disposiciones permanecerán en vigor hasta nuevo aviso:

- Se mantiene la dispensa general de la obligación dominical de asistir a misa.
- Se anima a las personas de poblaciones vulnerables a quedarse en casa. Se debe desalentar a las personas de alto riesgo (p. Ej., Personas de 65 años o más, inmunodeprimidos o que tienen problemas de salud subyacentes) de prestar servicios en cualquier capacidad que los ponga en contacto con otras personas.
- La transmisión en vivo de Misas sigue disponible.
- No se permite compartir alimentos o bebidas antes o después de la Misa o cualquier otra reunión.

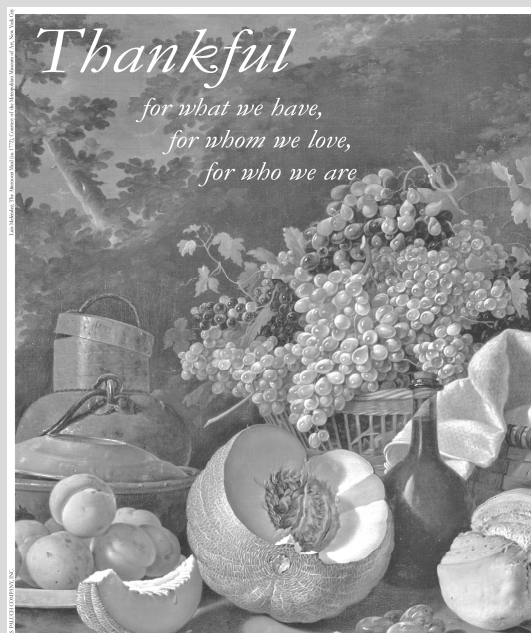

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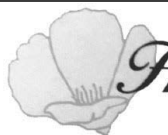
