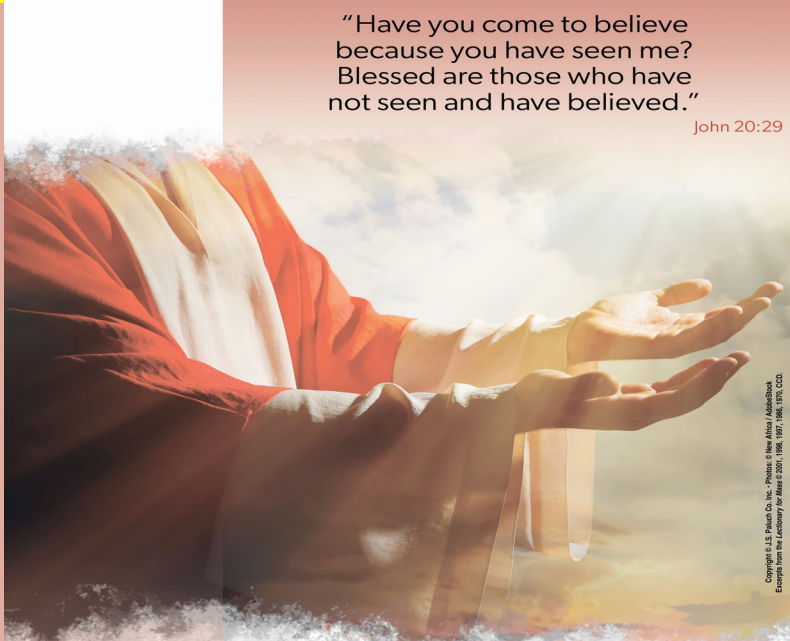

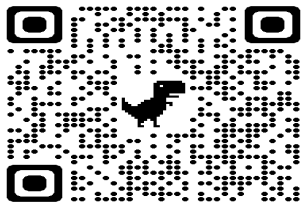

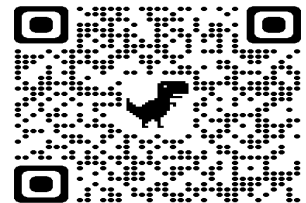

Fr. Jean's Message

Yahweh is tenderness and pity

The second Sunday of Easter has been known since 2000 as Divine Mercy Sunday. It was instituted by Pope John Paul II on the day of Saint Faustina's canonization. She not only experienced Divine Mercy in her life, but also was one of the apostles of divine benevolence. Mercy comes from two Latin words *Miseri* which means "the poor" and *Cor* which means "the heart", therefore, *Miseri-cor*, it is the heart towards the poor. God himself reveals that he is the God of mercy (Exodus 3, 7-9; 34, 6-9; Isaiah 49,15). His heart always beats for us. He has compassion for all forms of suffering. "The word mercy means a heart made miserable by the misery of others", says Saint Thomas Aquinas. The sublime act of divine mercy is the offering of Christ on the cross, the redemptive act for humans. Divine mercy is our hope. On this last day of the octave of Easter, remember Jesus tells us: "Blessed are the merciful: they shall have mercy shown them."

Yahvé es clemente y misericordioso

El segundo domingo de Pascua se conoce desde el año 2000 como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Fue instituido por el Papa Juan Pablo II el día de la canonización de Santa Faustina. Ella no solo experimentó la Divina Misericordia en su vida, sino que también fue una de los apóstoles de la benevolencia divina. Misericordia proviene de dos palabras latinas *Miseri* que significa "los pobres" y *Cor* que significa "el corazón", por lo tanto, *Miseri-cor*, es el corazón hacia los pobres. Dios mismo revela que es el Dios de misericordia (Éxodos 3,7-9; 34, 6-9; Isaías 49,15). Su corazón siempre late por nosotros. Él tiene compasión por todas las formas de sufrimiento. "La palabra misericordia", dice Santo Tomás de Aquino, significa un corazón miserable por la miseria de los demás". El acto sublime de la misericordia divina es la ofrenda de Cristo en la cruz, el acto redentor para el género humano. La misericordia divina es la esperanza de los hombres. En este último día de la octava de Pascua, hay que recordar que Jesús nos dice: "Bienaventurados los misericordiosos, porque ellos alcanzarán misericordia".

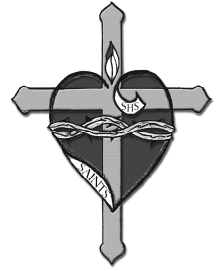

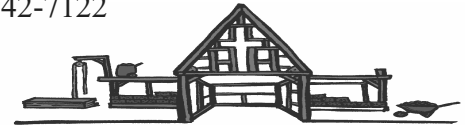

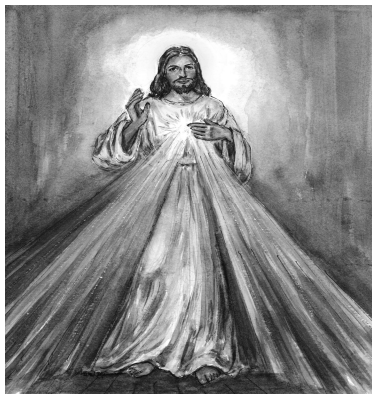
