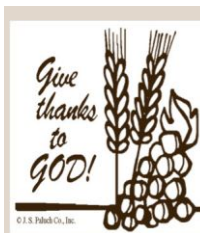

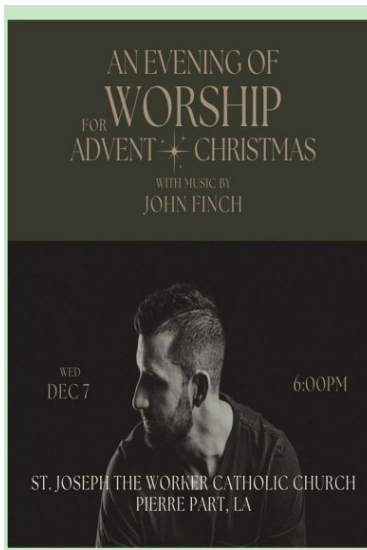
The Veteran's Day Ceremony at Veteran's Park will be on Sunday, November 13 at 11:30am. Everyone is invited to attend.
