

BEST PRACTICES FOR ACHIEVING THE PARISH GOAL

The following plan for Commitment Sunday is provided to help your parish's participation in the 2024 CSA be a success. This plan is strongly encouraged to be followed as it has the best practices that can help each parish reach their goals. The pastor's full support of the Appeal, both personally and publicly cannot be over-emphasized for its success at each parish or mission.

PROMOTION OF 2024 CSA

- Place posters in high traffic areas around the parish
- Bulletin Announcements

- Pulpit Announcements/Homily Help
- Petition in Prayers of the Faithful

COMMITMENT SUNDAY WEEKEND

Pledge Envelopes—Place pledge envelopes, with pencils if possible, in the pews before the first Mass on Commitment Sunday weekend. It is very important that pledge envelopes be restocked after each Mass so that each person or family has the opportunity to give a gift or make a pledge.

Letter from Bishop Kihneman—Parishes will receive a letter via email from Bishop Kihneman that is to be read at all Masses on the weekend of February 17-18, 2024. It is extremely important that the bishop's letter be read during the homily at all Masses on this weekend. All parishes are being supplied with digital bulletin inserts to be posted or handed out with bulletins for this weekend.

Collection of Pledges/Gifts—The collection of pledges/gifts should be done during the normal Offertory of the Mass without the need of a special CSA collection. The pledges/gifts should be separated from the parish offertory during the normal process by your parish counting team.

PLEASE DO NOT OPEN OR COUNT CSA pledges/gifts at the parish; rather, please put them in an envelope for delivery to the Pastoral Center the following week. It is very important that CSA pledges and gifts not be separated from their envelopes in order to give us every ability to match the gift with the donor.

Delivery of Pledges to Pastoral Center—Because in-pew pledges/gifts will contain checks and cash, it is requested that parishes NOT mail them, but rather deliver them to the Pastoral Center. Pick up from the parishes in the Northern Deanery will be provided.

PLANNING AND ACTION TEM CHECKLIST

February 5-9, 2024

Have 2024 Appeal and Participation posters displayed in high traffic areas.

- ♦ Review this CSA Booklet and be familiar with the 2024 CSA implementation.
- ♦ Have a plan to place pledge envelopes/pencils in pews prior to first Mass.
- ♦ Have a plan with ushers to replenish pledge envelopes after each Mass.

All Masses - February 10-11, 2024

- ♦ Have 2024 Appeal and Participation posters displayed in high traffic areas.
- Pulpit announcement at all Masses promoting the Commitment Sunday.
 *Mention that parishioners should have received the CSA letter in the mail.
- ◇ Pastor encourages all families to participate in the 2024 CSA.

Ash Wednesday Masses February 14, 2024

- ♦ Have 2024 CSA and Participation posters displayed in high traffic areas.
- ♦ Pulpit announcement at all Masses promoting the CSA Commitment Sunday.
- Priest invites parishioners to consider making a pledge to the CSA this year.
- ♦ Announcements for Ash Wednesday should mention CSA begins this Sat/Sun.

February 17-18, 2024

- ♦ In-Pew Pledge envelopes placed in all pews, cry rooms, choir, and presider's chair.
- ♦ Pencils placed in all pews, cry rooms, choir, and at presider's chair.
- Plan to restock pews with envelopes has been reviewed with ushers for each Mass.

CHECKLIST CONTINUED

COMMITMENT SUNDAY Weekend Masses: February 17-18, 2024

- ♦ Mass begins and proceeds as normal up to the homily.
- ♦ Pastor offers homily (full or abbreviated at his discretion).
- Pastor introduces, gives brief explanation and offers his support of the Appeal.
- ♦ 2024 CSA letter from Bishop Kihneman is read at all Masses.
- After the pastor reads CSA letter, he invites all to pledge/offer a one-time gift if they haven't already done so for this year's appeal. Priest completes his pledge.
- Please use the prayer included in this packet during Prayers of the Faithful.
- Pledges/gifts are collected during the normal Offertory.

February 19-23, 2024 (Week Following Commitment Sunday)

- Separate CSA envelopes from parish Offertory.
- ♦ DO NOT OPEN, COUNT, OR MAIL CSA pledge envelopes and gifts.
- ♦ Place all CSA envelopes in an envelope.
- Deliver envelope with pledges to Pastoral Center.
- ♦ Diocesan staff will coordinate pledge pick up from parishes unable to deliver.

February 24-25, 2024 (Weekend Masses)

- ♦ Invite parishioners to join the parish in supporting the 2024 CSA.
- ♦ Pulpit announcement thanking parishioners who have pledged to 2024 CSA.
- ♦ Bulletin announcements thanking parishioners for support of the 2024 CSA.
- ◇ Prayer in Prayers of the Faithful for a continued success of the 2024 CSA.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Bishop Kihneman's Letter

A letter from Bishop Kihneman will be read at all Masses. This is the bishop's direct invitation to parishioners of the diocese to join him in his ministry of the diocesan Church through prayer and financial support. It is extremely important that this letter be read at all of the Masses on Commitment Weekend during the time of the homily.

Why are In-Pew Envelopes important?

It is important that every parishioner and family be given the opportunity to make a pledge or give a one-time gift during Commitment Weekend Masses. Especially if they have not already done so for this year's appeal. For this reason, envelopes have been sent to the parishes so that pews can be restocked after each Mass. We are using a new envelope this year that is branded specifically for the 2024 CSA. Please do not use any other In-Pew envelopes for this year's appeal other than those provided in your 2024 CSA material.

Why do I need to deliver pledges instead of just mailing them?

With In-Pew pledges/gifts, we anticipate checks/cash to be given at Masses on Commitment Sunday weekend. To prevent them from being accidentally lost in the mail, we ask that these pledges/gifts be delivered to the Pastoral Center. If you are unable to deliver these envelopes in a timely manner please call the Office of Mission Advancement to coordinate a pick up for your parish.

What do I do with CSA pledges that arrive after Commitment Sunday? For pledges and gifts that arrive after the initial batch has been delivered to the Pastoral Center, we ask that these pledges be put in one envelope and either delivered or mailed to the Pastoral Center on a weekly basis. Please do not hold on to pledges/gifts more than 5 business days.

How long should I keep the 2024 CSA material out and on display?

CSA posters should be on display throughout the year, and leave the pledge envelopes in the pews for at least three consecutive weekends. After the third weekend please make pledge envelopes available in the back of the church near a 2024 CSA Appeal poster. It is highly encouraged that a pulpit announcement, with an invitation to join in the bishop's ministry of the diocesan Church through support of the 2024 Catholic Sharing Appeal be offered at all Masses throughout the month of March, 2024.

What do I do with the left over pledge envelopes?

Any in-pew envelopes for the 2024 CSA should be discarded at the end of the year. Please keep a stock of envelopes available to parishioners near the 2024 CSA poster.

Where can I track my Parish Progress and Participation reports?

2024 CSA Parish Progress Reports will be posted to the diocesan web page starting March 4, 2024 and can be found at www.biloxidiocese.org. Look for the link titled "2024 CSA Reports."

What if my parish exceeds its goal?

If your parish meets its diocesan goal with payments received, all money received in excess of the goal will be returned to the parish at a rate of 100%. This policy will remain current for the 2024 Appeal, but will be under review for future Appeals based on this year's performance in meeting the total diocesan goal.
